28. Administrative sources exploitation poses an important condition of enhancing efficiency of statistical activities and data quality, and of accelerating provision of statistical information.
29. In conclusion, we would like to point out in Slovakia are favourable conditions of creating and exploiting of registers and administrative data sources for purposes of state statistics. Preparation and exploitation of them is enabled mainly by the Act on State Statistics and rather fruitful co-operation of the SR Statistical Office with relevant institutions keeping registers and administrative sources.
30. For the nearest future we intend to focus more attention to co-operation with the Central Taxation Office, Social Insurance Agency, health insurance companies and the National Labour Office.
