STATISTICS 

- Replies from 38 countries and 2 international organizations
 - General support for the chosen methodology to select the indicators and the resulting indicator set
 - The vast majority considered the report ready for approval
 - Task Force will update the Report to reflect the comments received
- 16 offices have started to pilot test the initial set of indicators
- The initial indicator set will provide the basis for developing a global set of key climate change-related indicators by UNSD
- Further work will be required to develop methodologies and data sources, and to refine the initial indicator set
