- Data integration
  - February 2017; paper by UNECE and HLG-MOS (ECE/CES/2017/8)

## Measuring governance

- Document provides excellent summary of current work
- Praia City Group addressing conceptual issues, methodology and tools for governance statistics
  - the in-depth review paper and survey carried out for this purpose provides input to work of the Praia group
- Bureau will review the need for further work in this area based on the outcomes of the Praia group

## Data integration

STATISTICS



- HLG-MOS project on data integration will continue in 2017 to develop collection of practical case studies and guidelines on data integration
  - Take into account comments received through electronic consultation
- UNECE meetings of experts on data collection will discuss issues of data integration
- CES Bureau will decide on possible follow-up activities in February 2018, based on HLG-MOS proposal
- CES will be informed at 2018 plenary session
