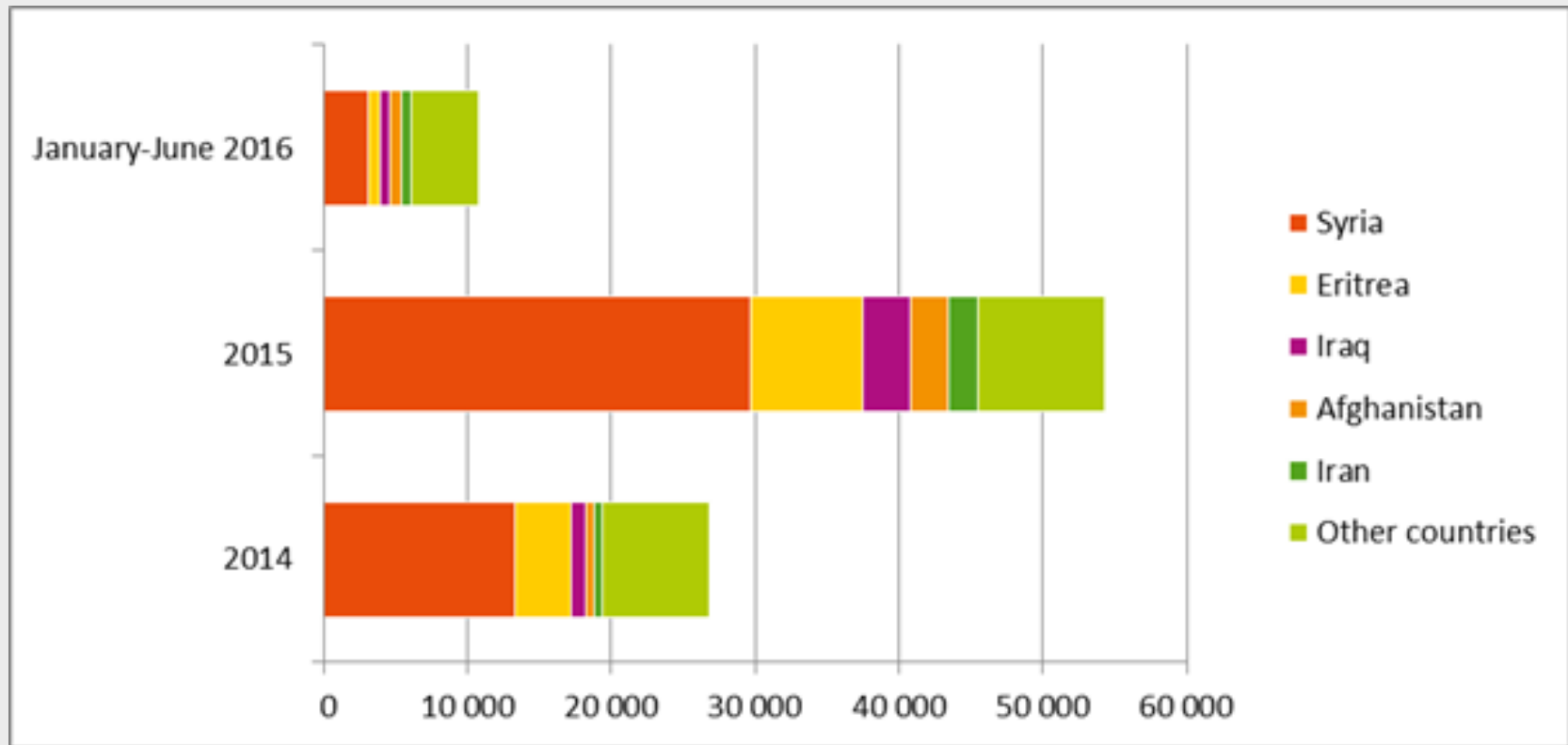

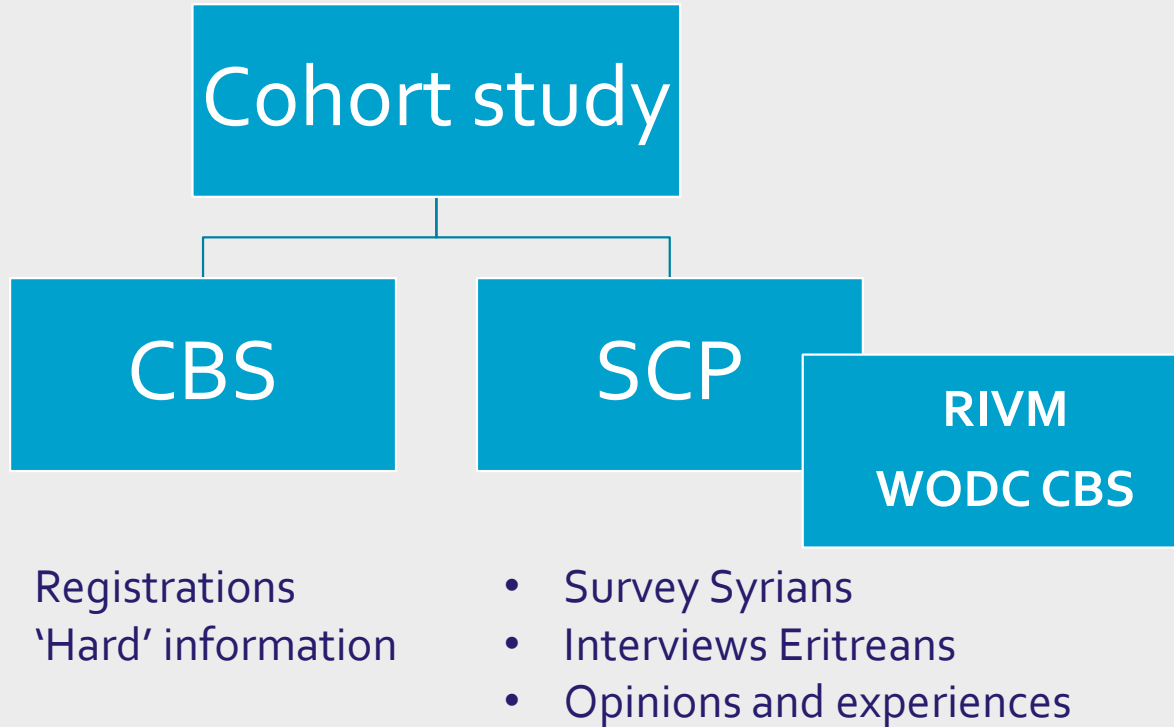

Influx into the Netherlands 2014-2016

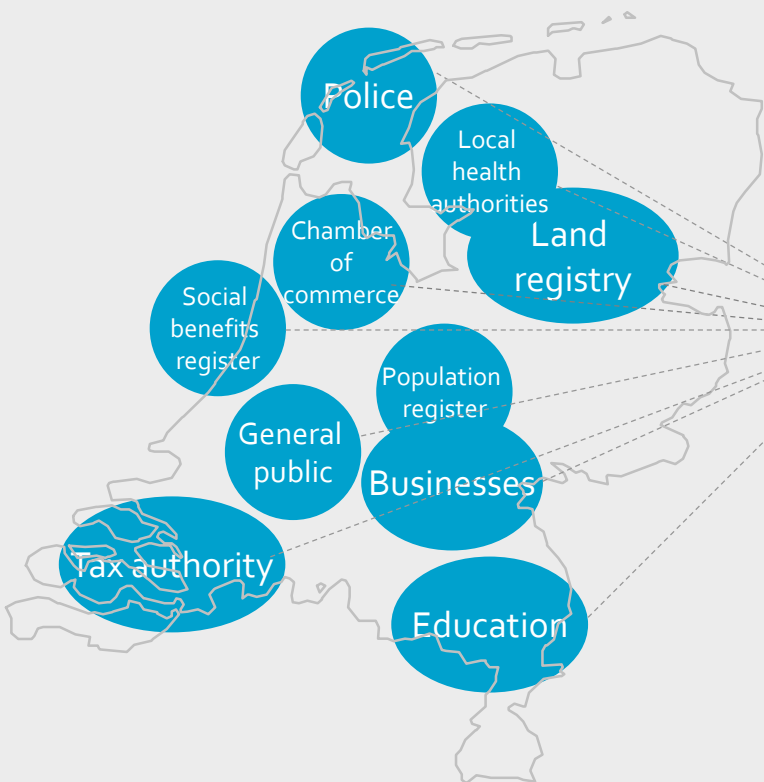

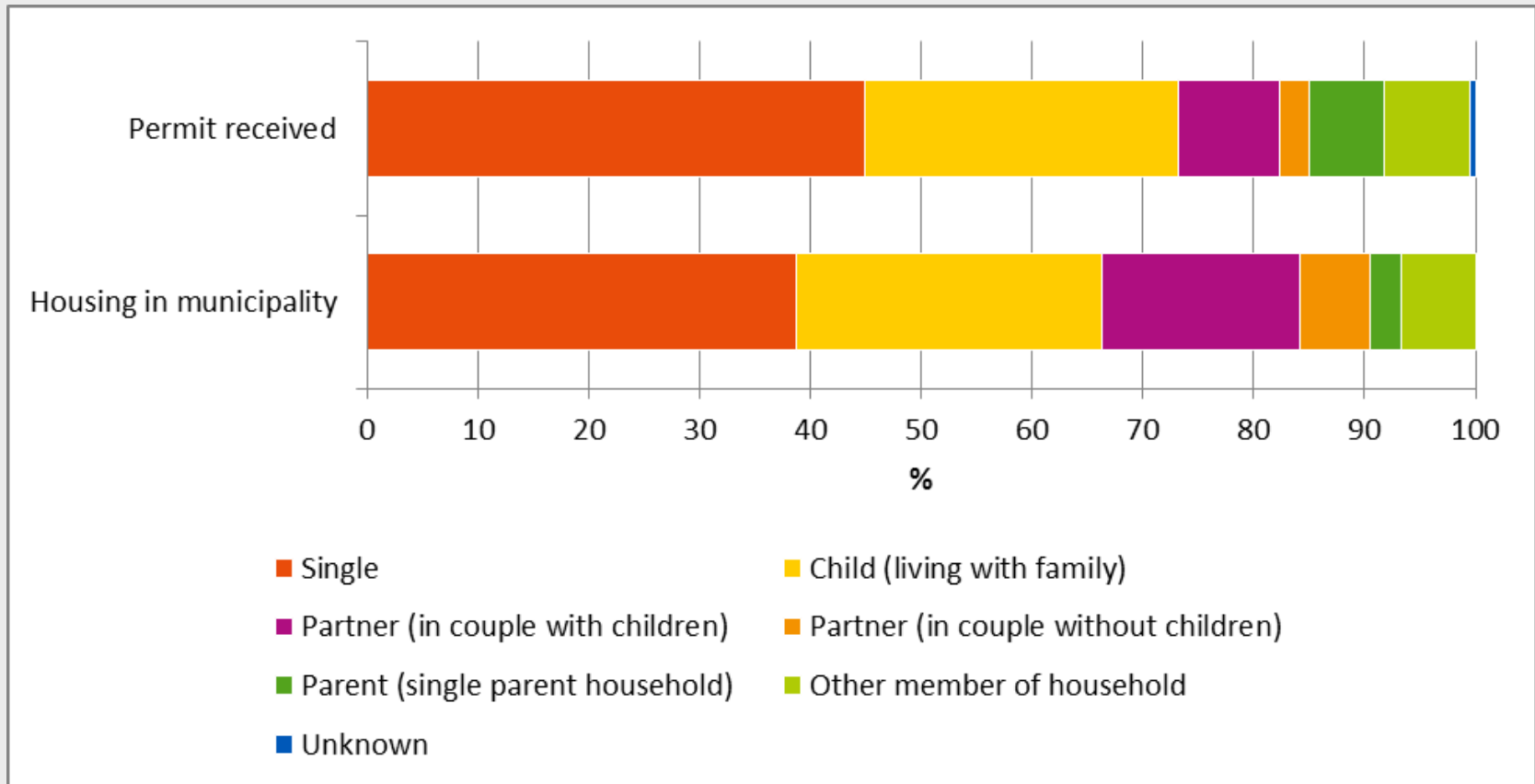

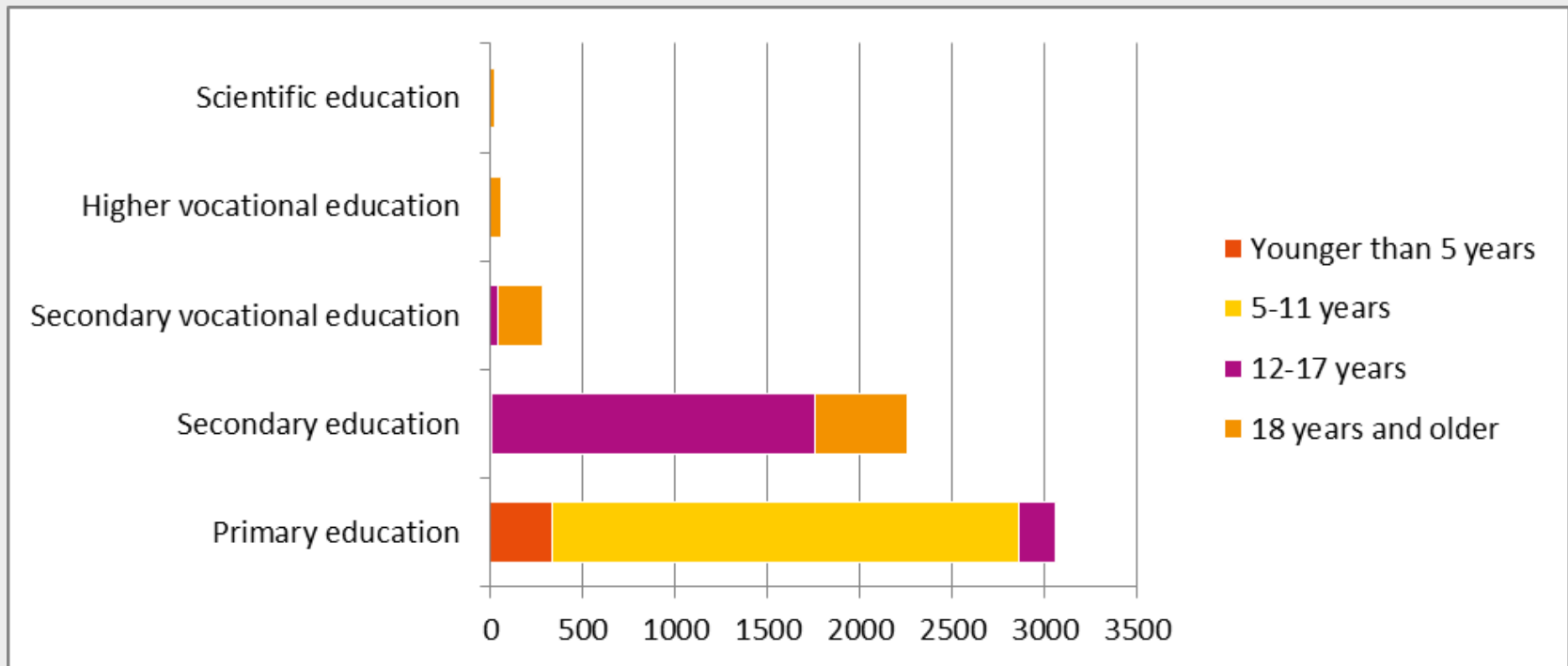
Refugees by age and sex



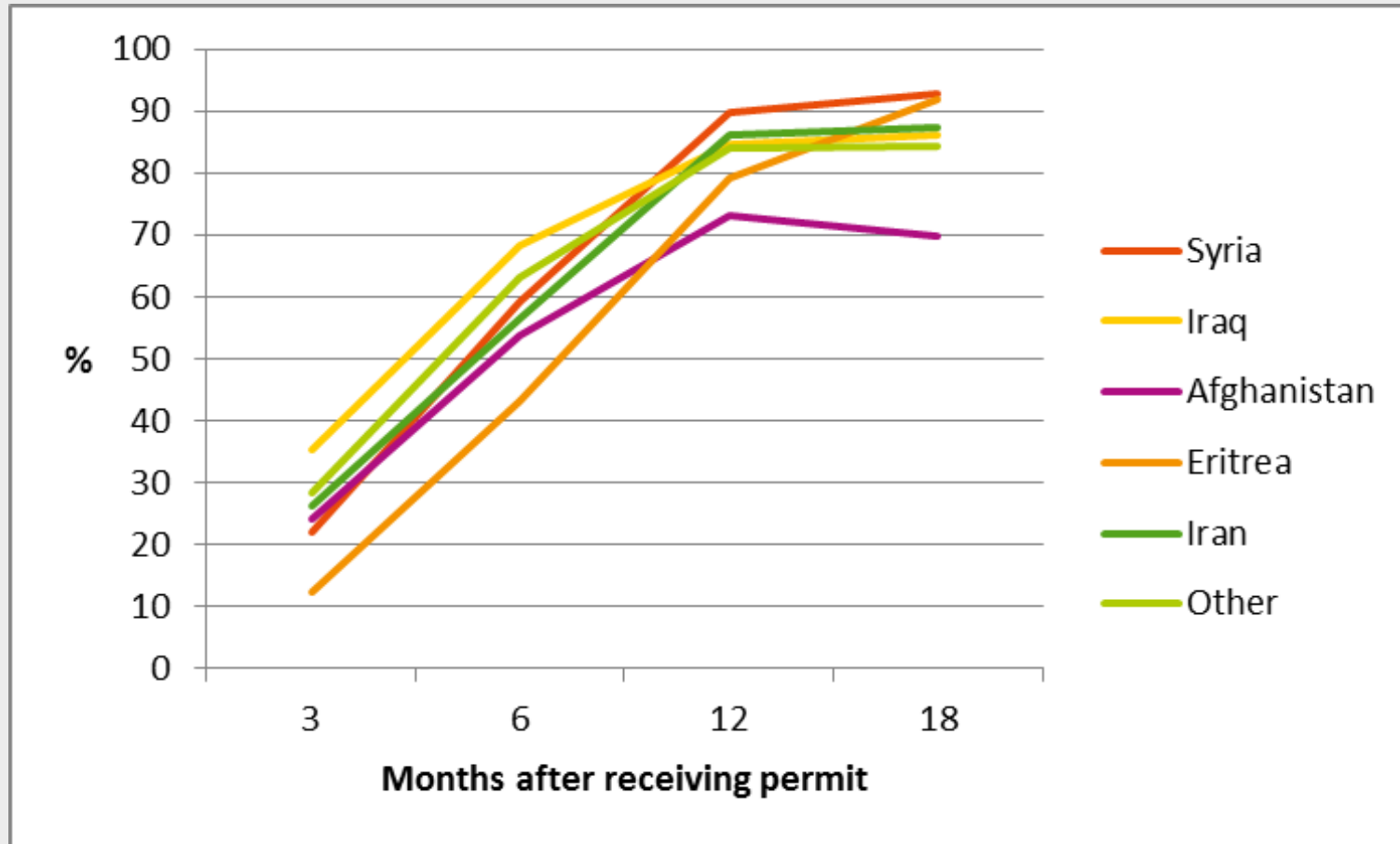

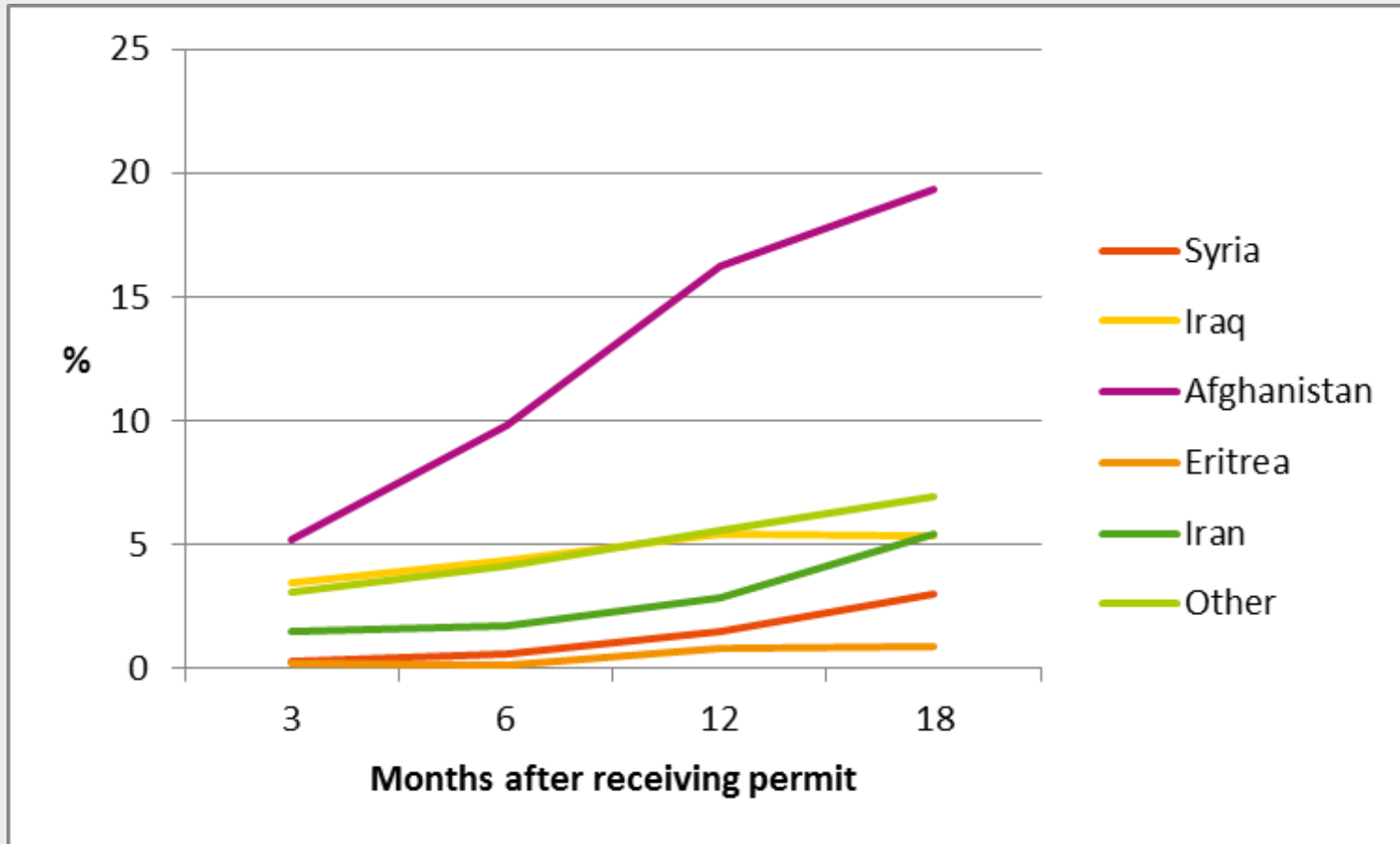

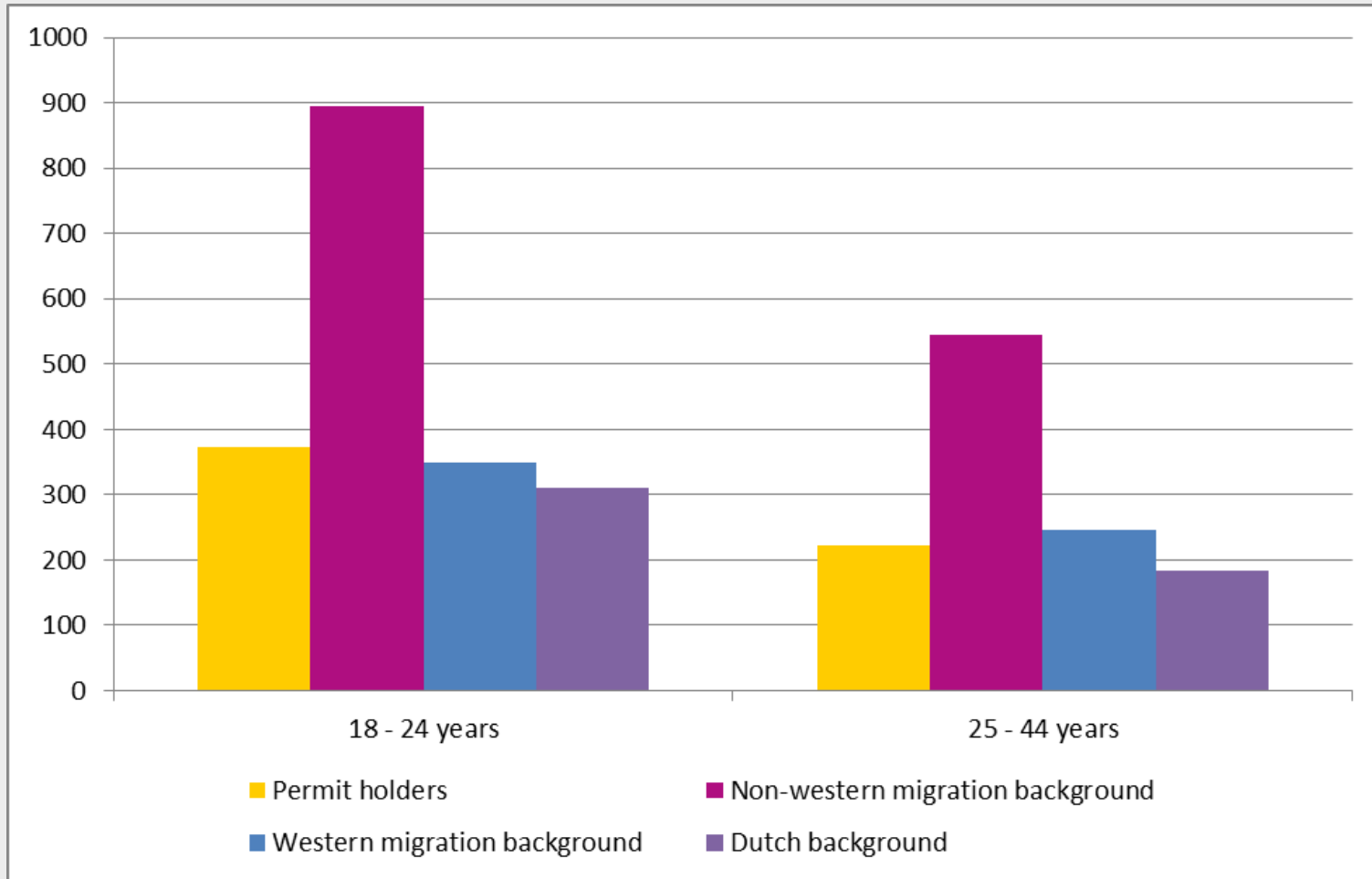
