Defining the target population



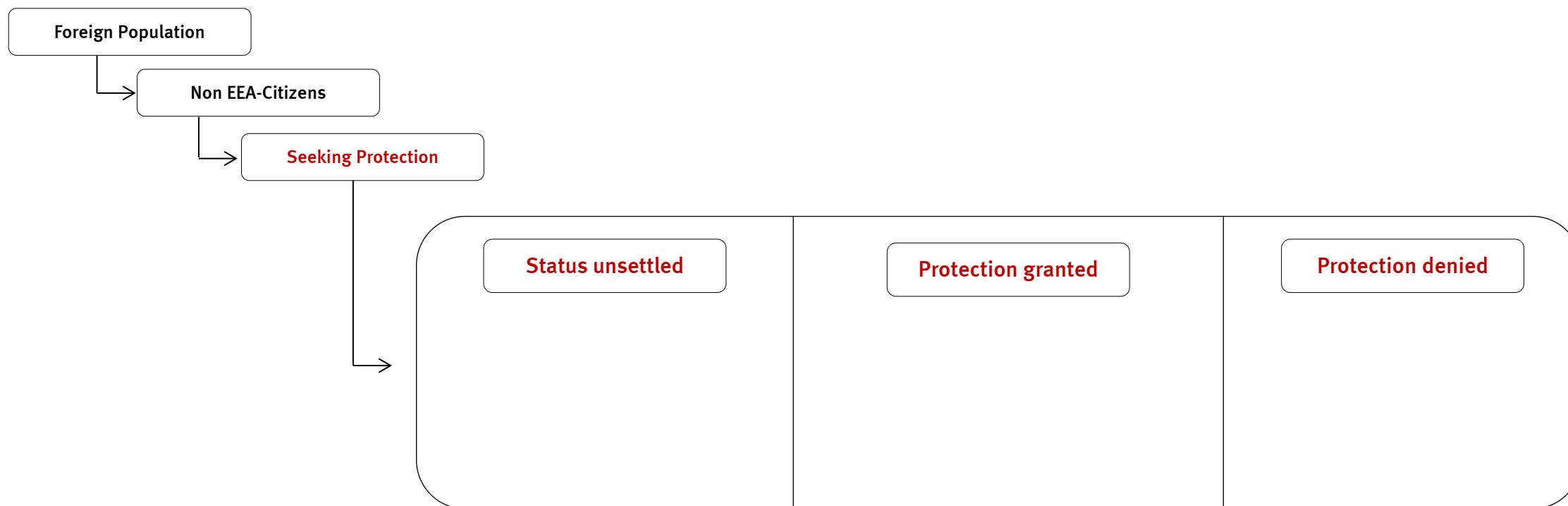
People seeking humanitarian protection are foreigners whose current legal residence status is based on humanitarian reasons.

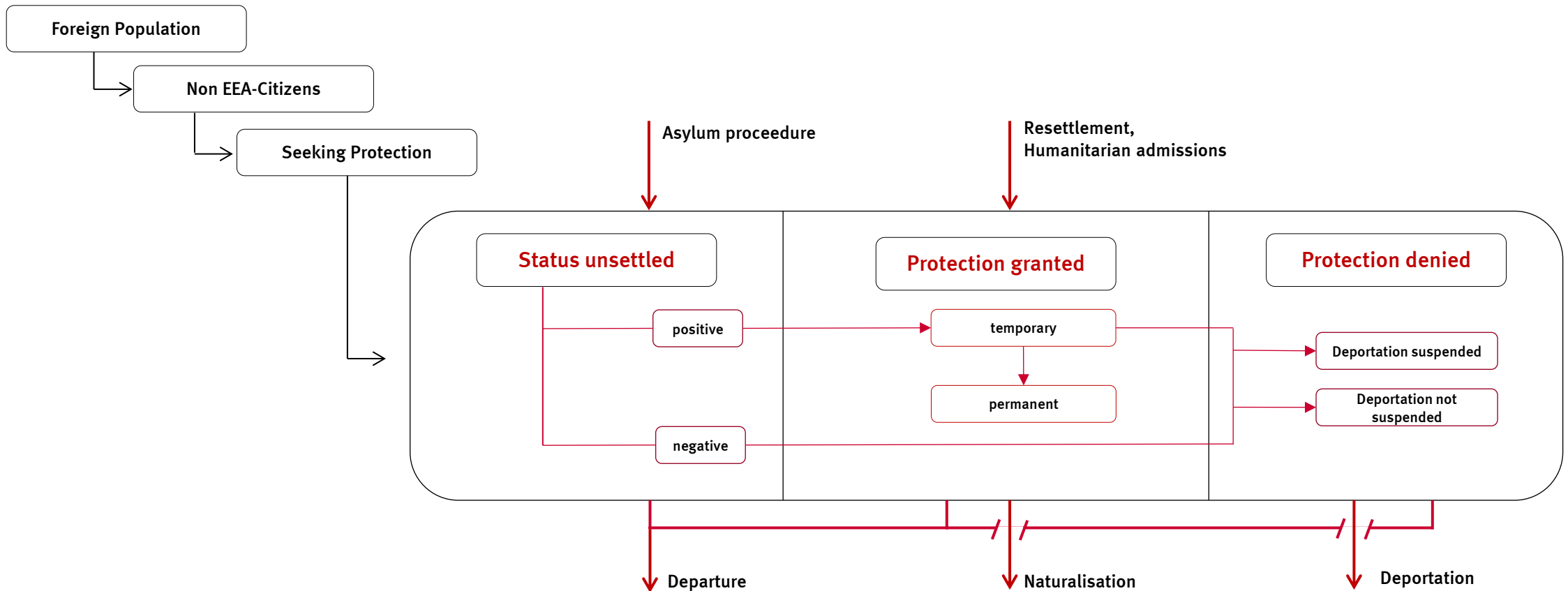

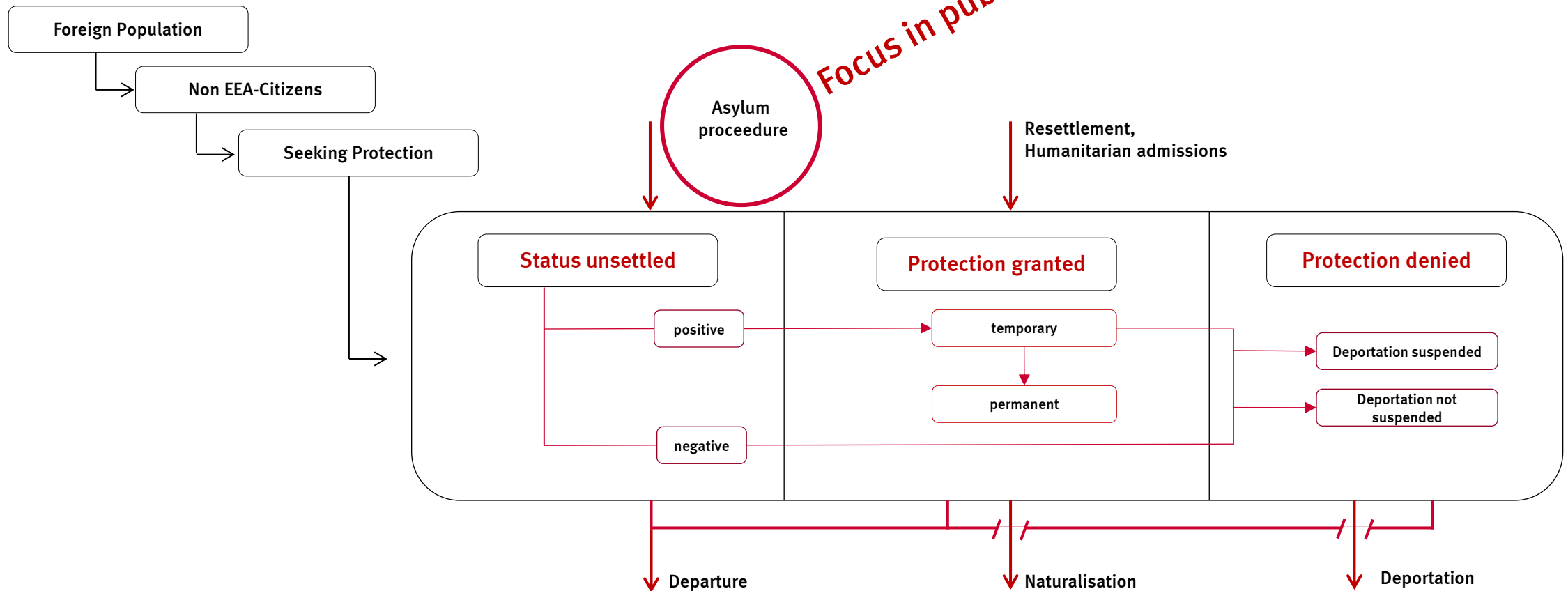

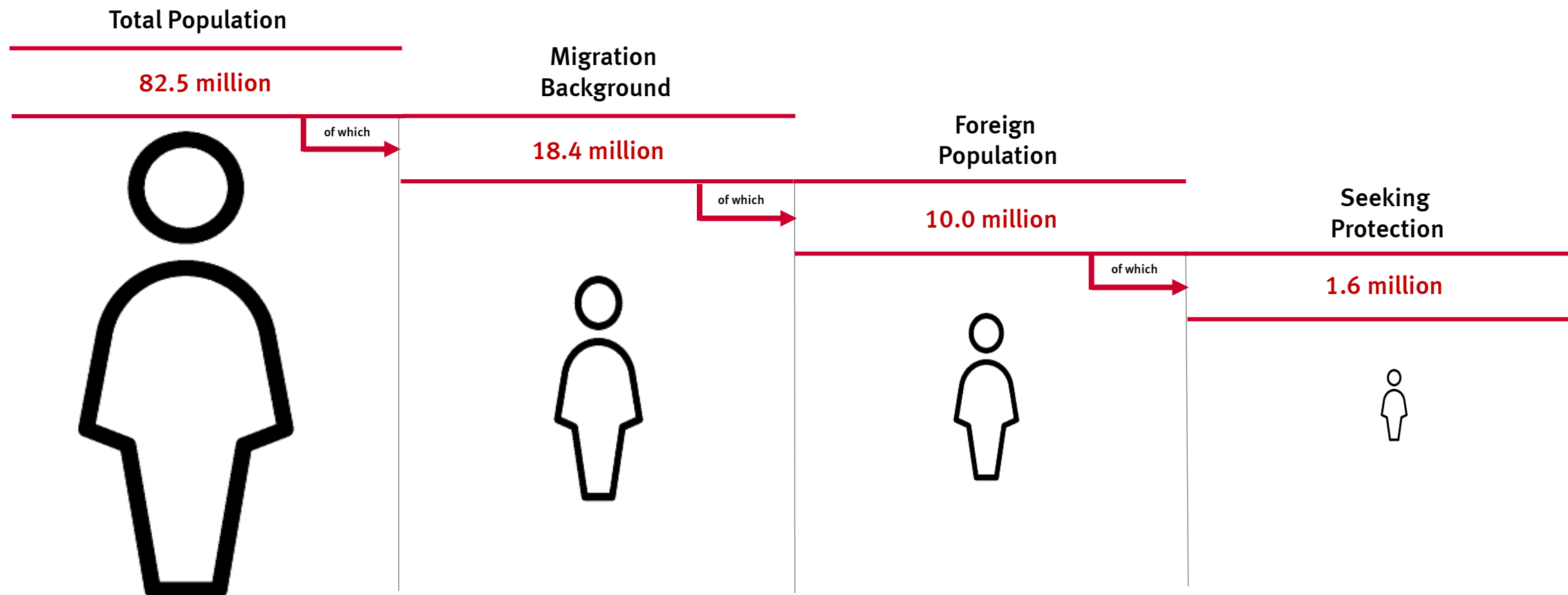

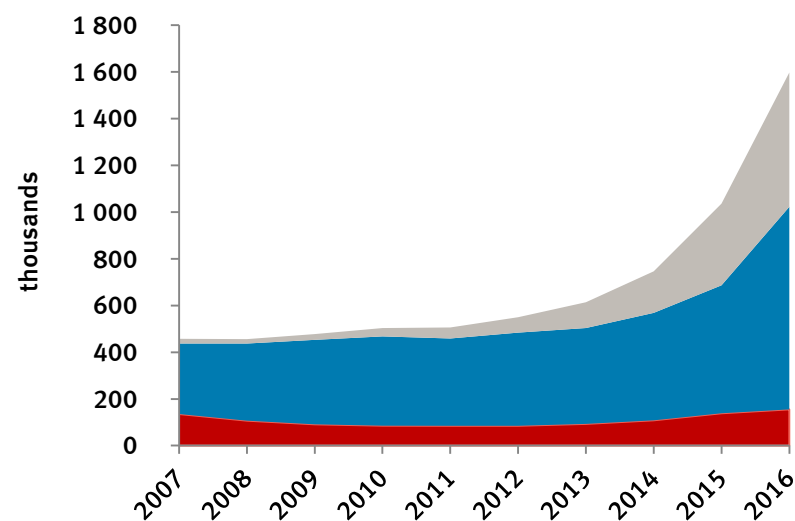
Placement in population statistics



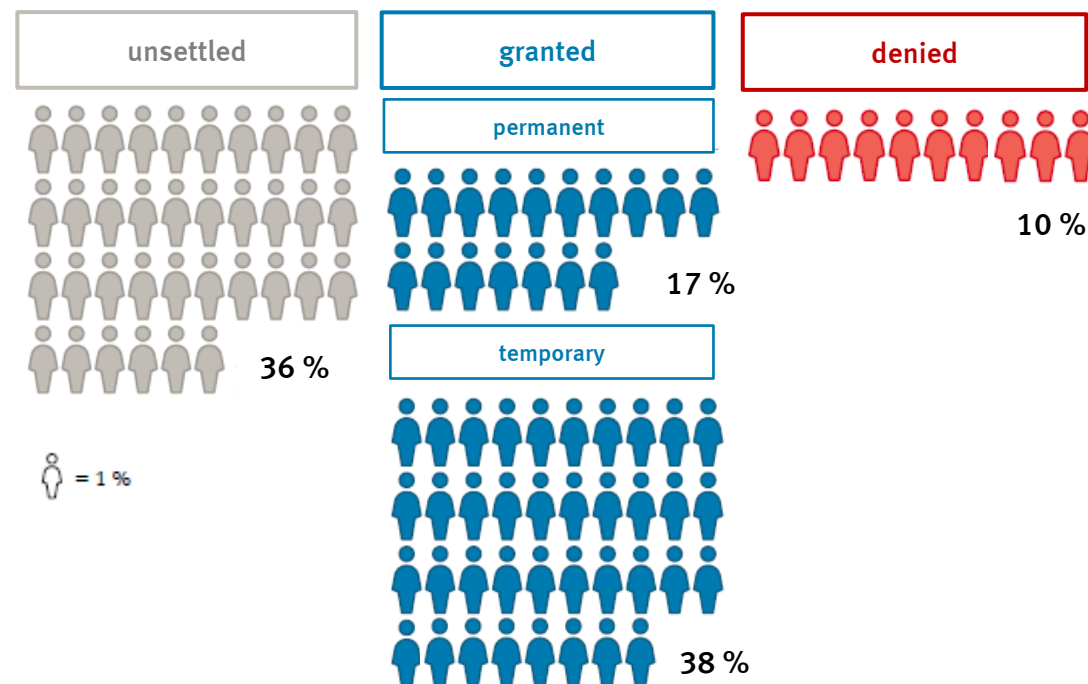

by protection status and over time

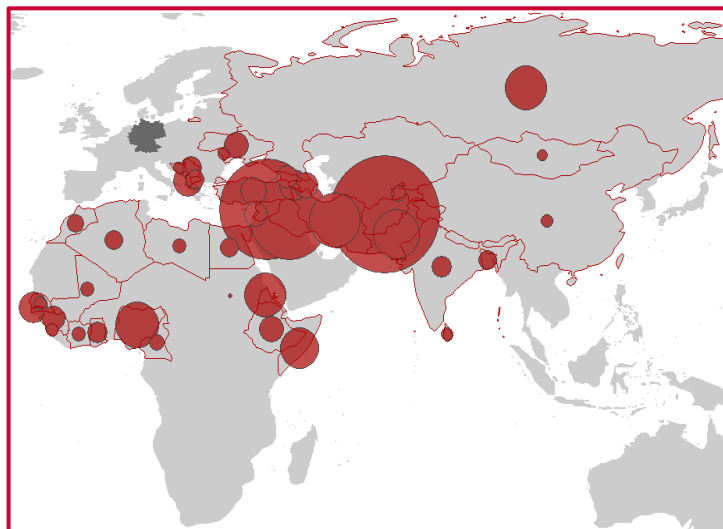

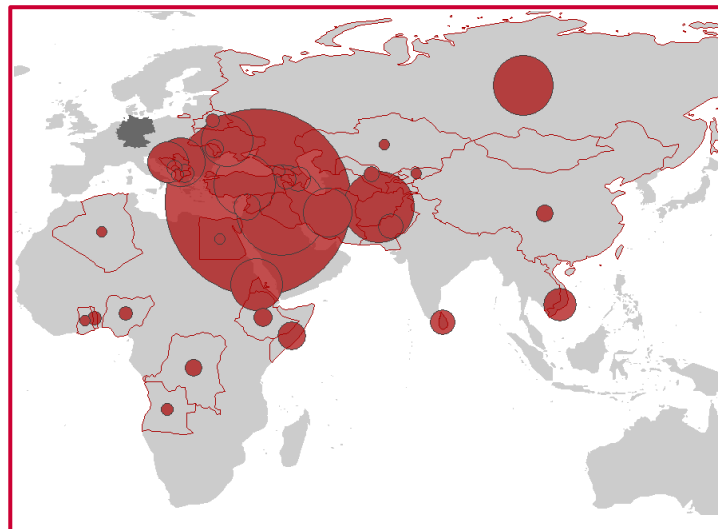

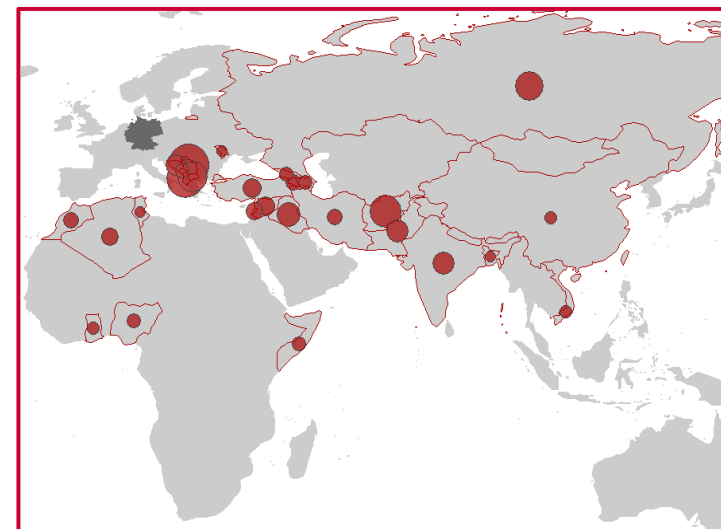

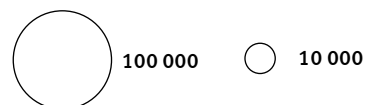

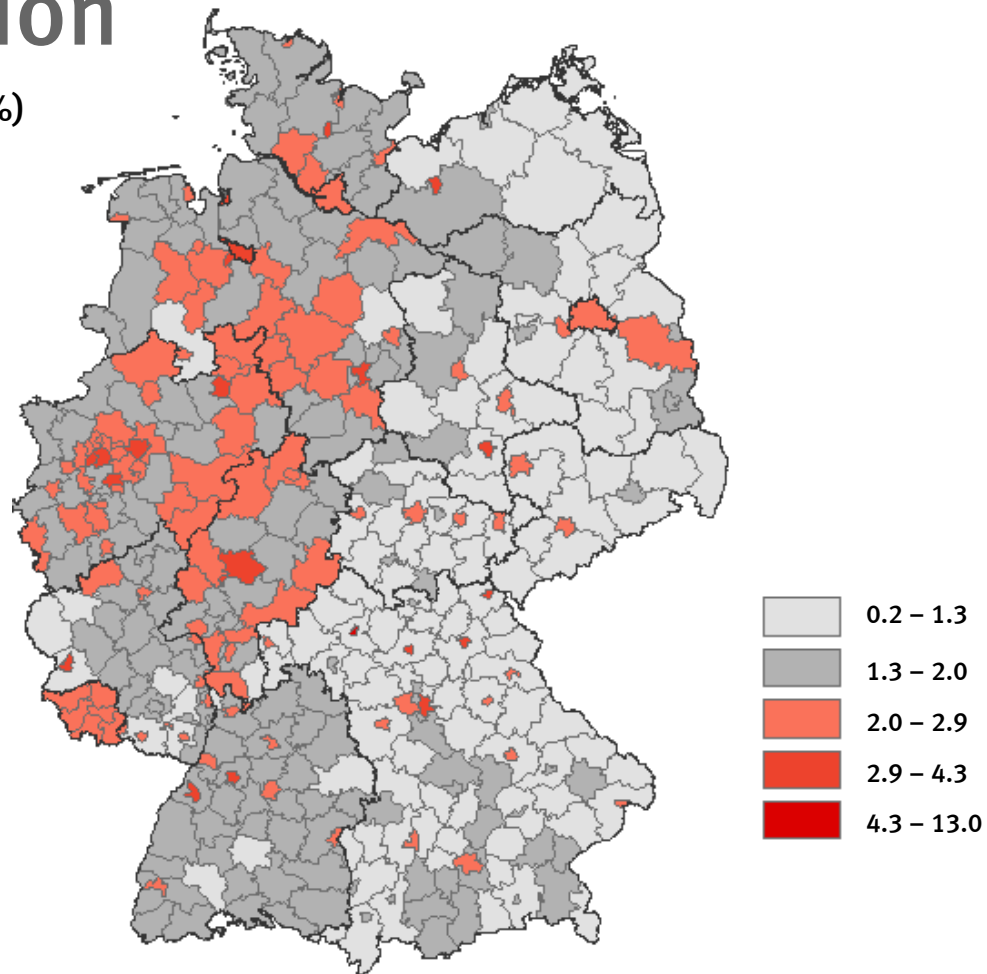

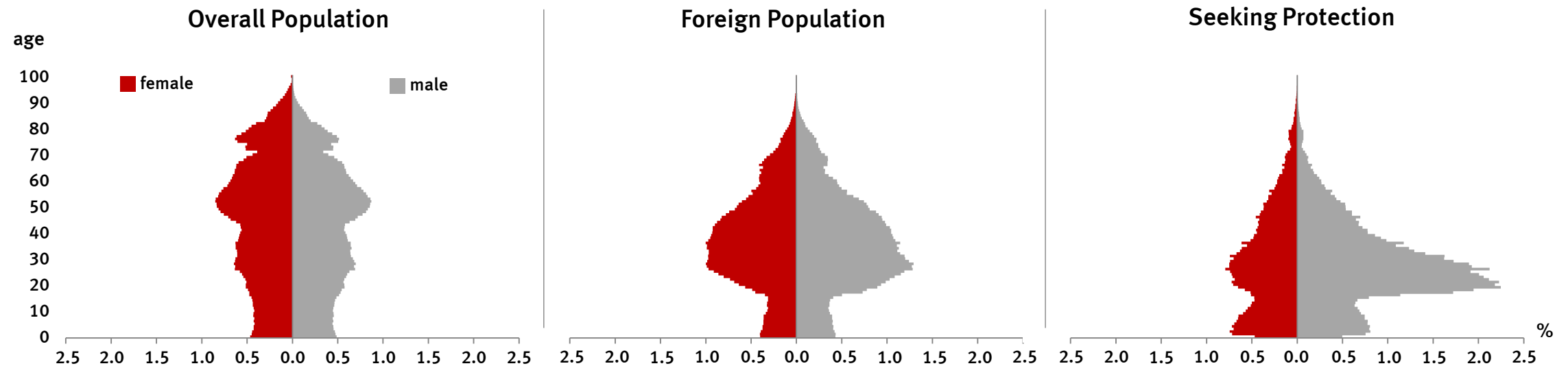
Regional distribution
