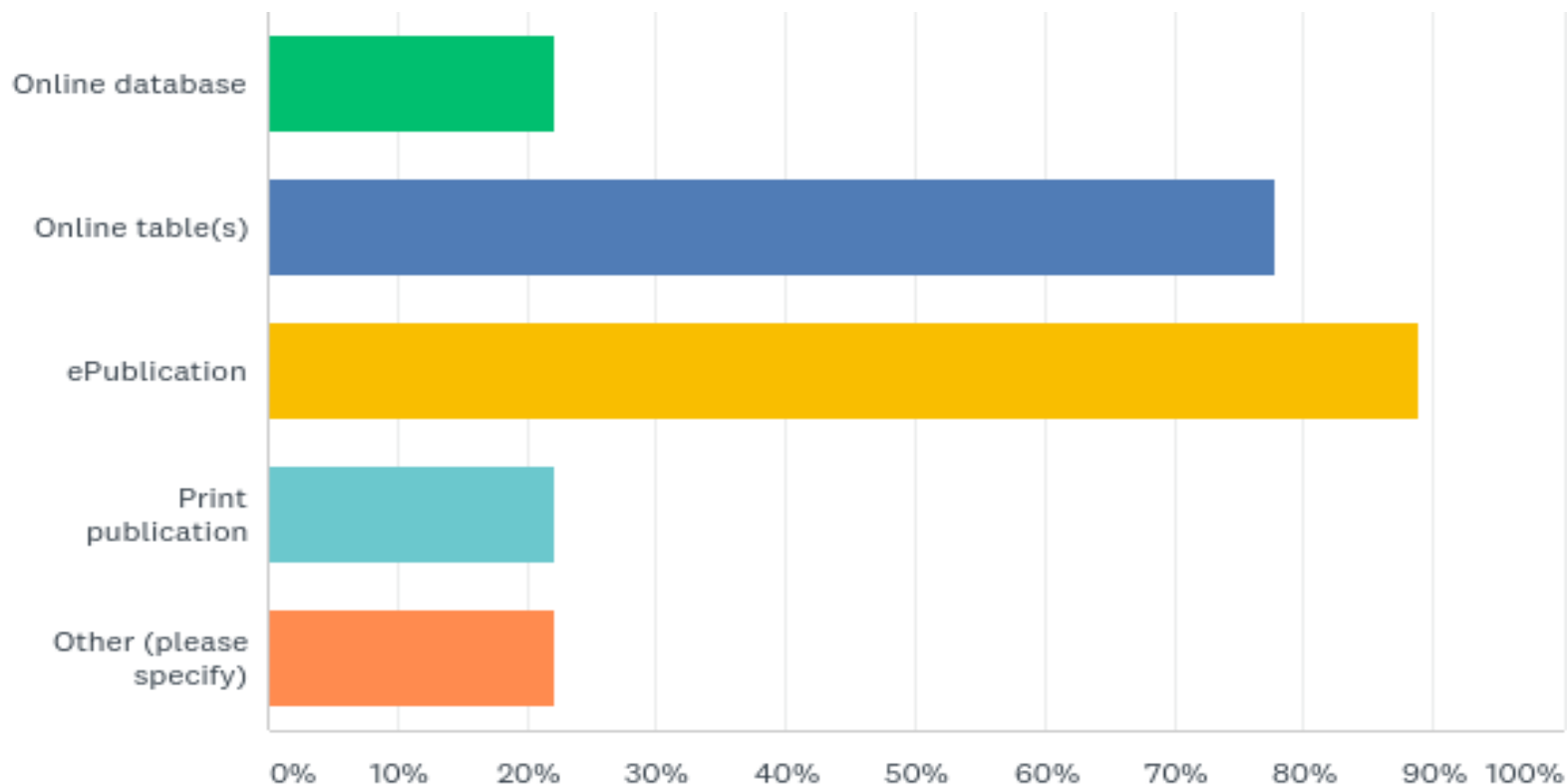

### STATISTICS



**US (BLS):** pay, hours, benefits, working conditions. No subjective measures published

**Italy:** indicators on work and life balance; job satisfaction, perceived insecurity of employment

**Switzerland:** Indicators of the dimensions where data is available

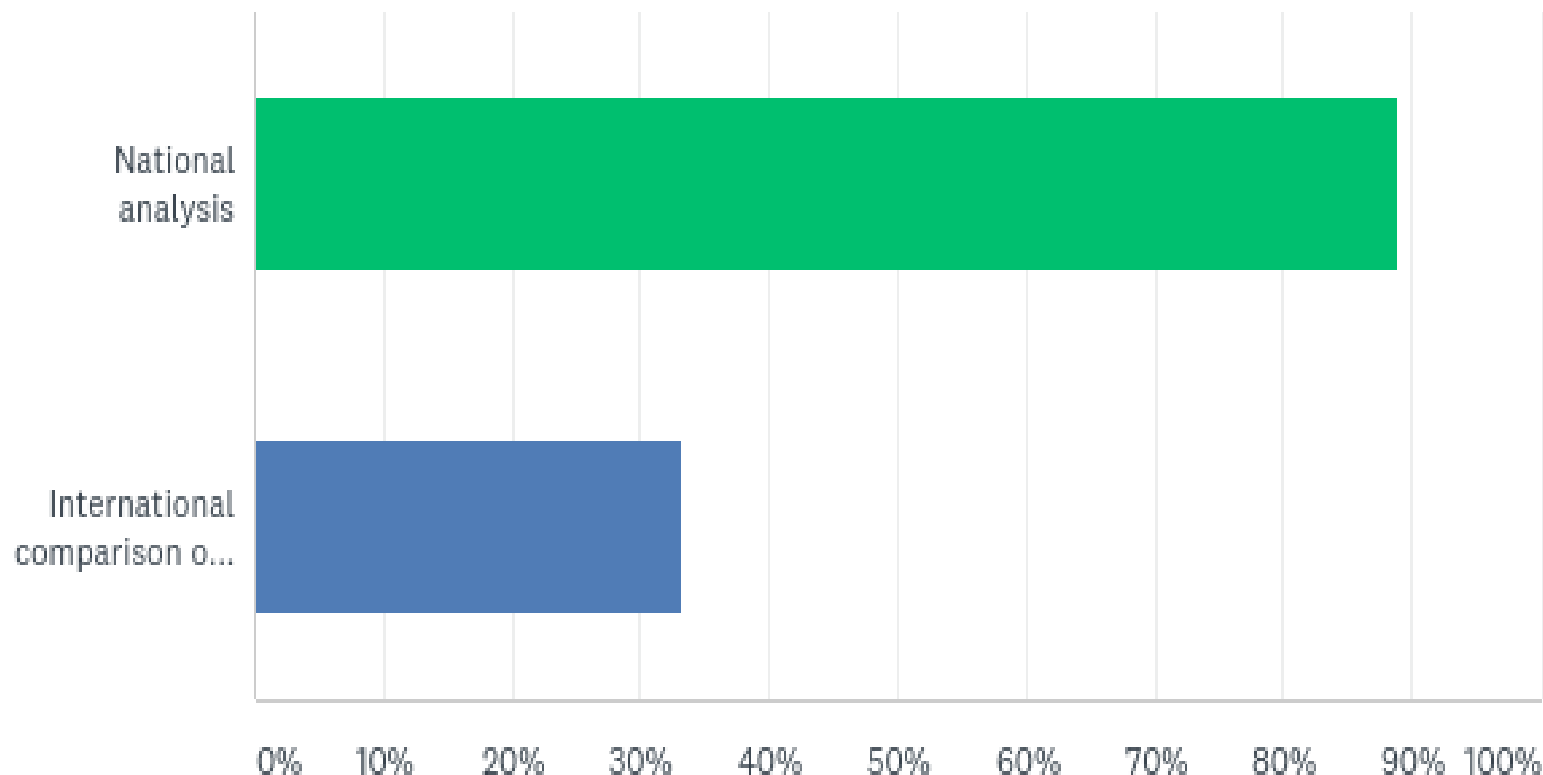
**Hungary:** no indicators yet, but data from LFS and e.g. administrative sources are available

**Lithuania:** selected indicators for all/most dimensions

**Germany:** selected indicators for all dimensions

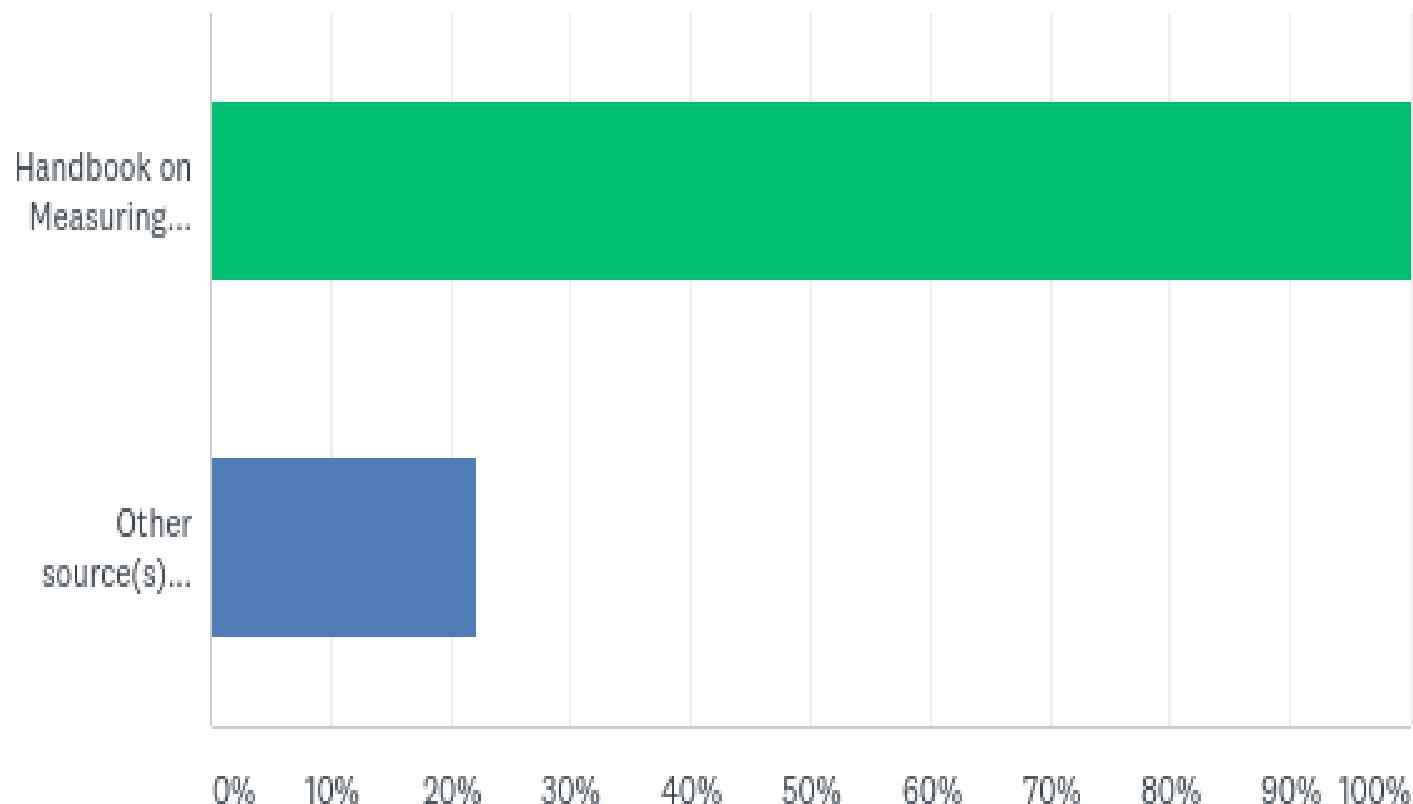

## Q8: Did you encounter any difficulties applying the recommendations of the Handbook on Measuring Quality of Employment? If yes, what were they?

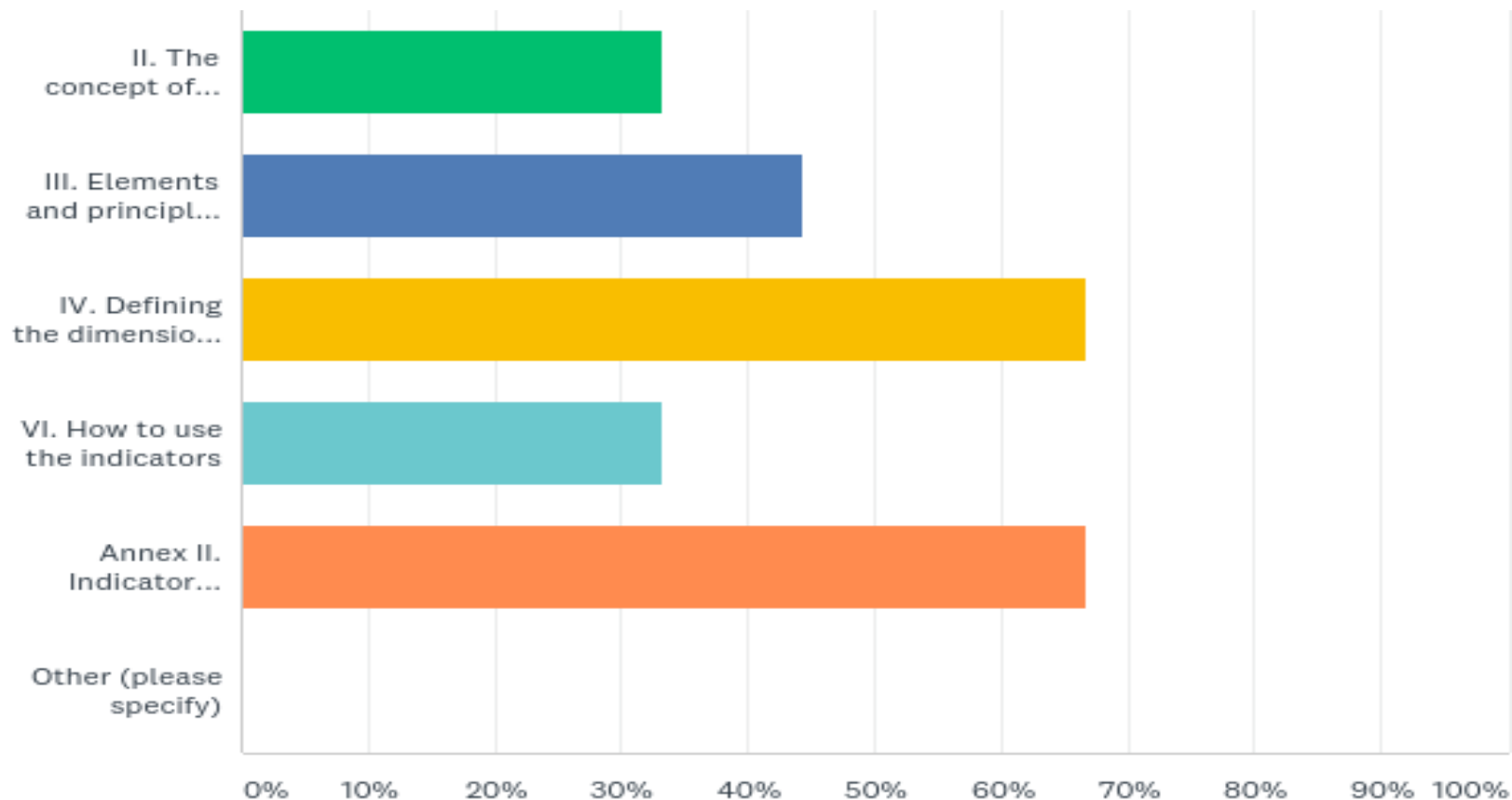

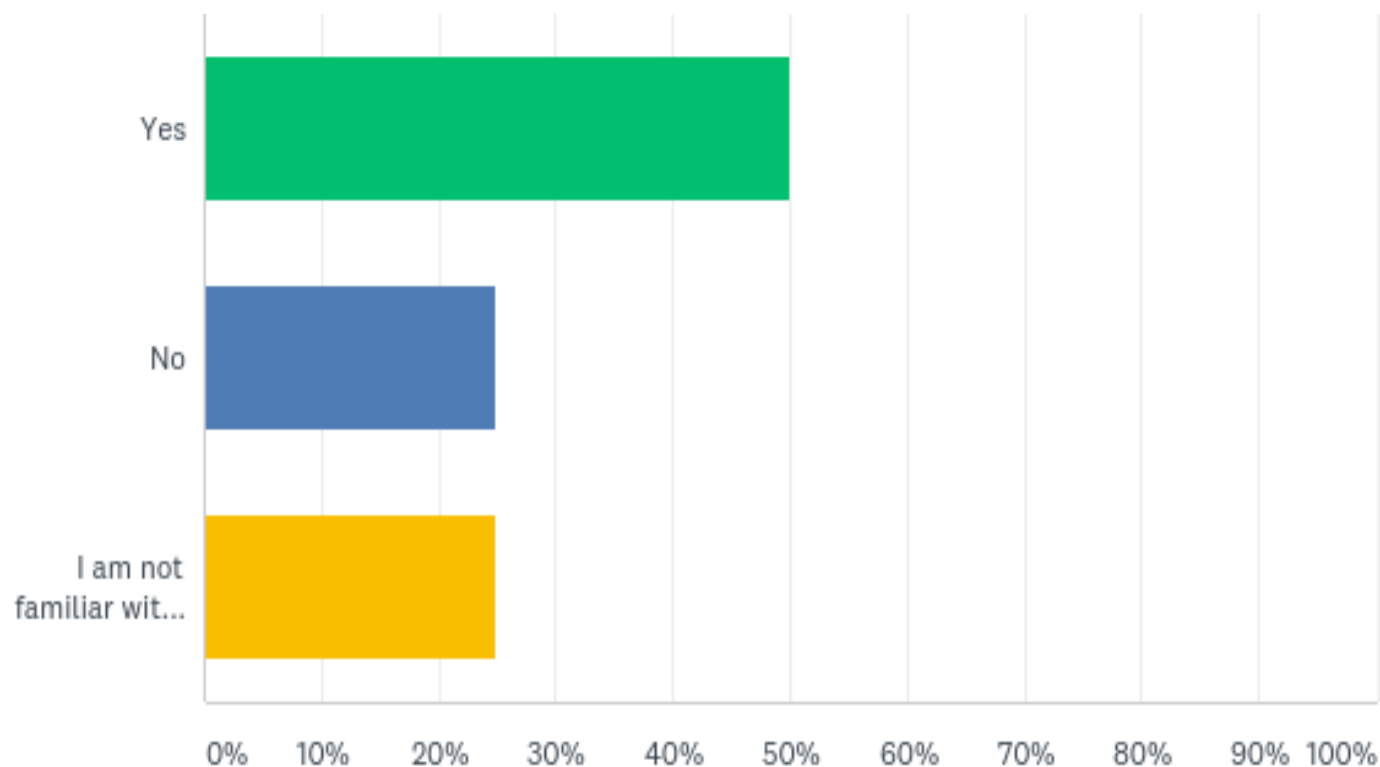

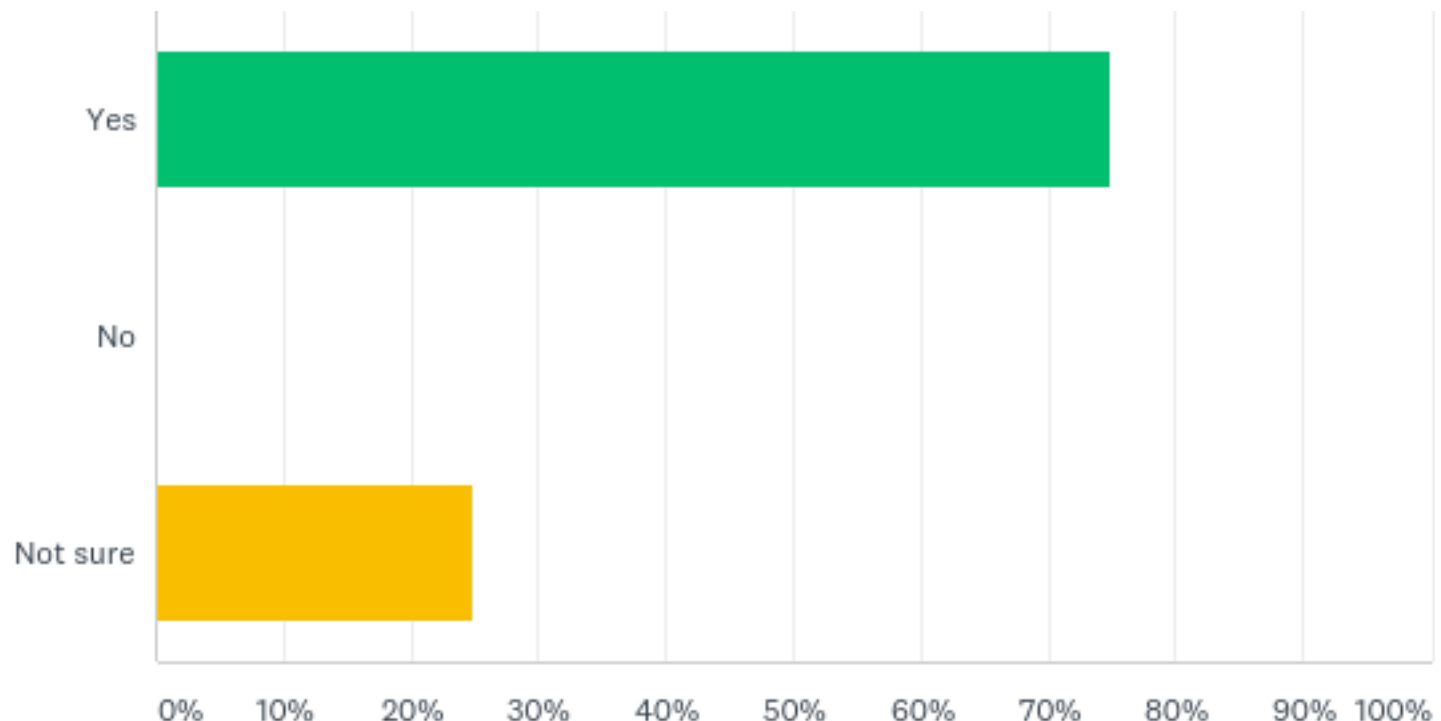
# Q11: Have you consulted the Eurostat database for quality of employment indicators before?

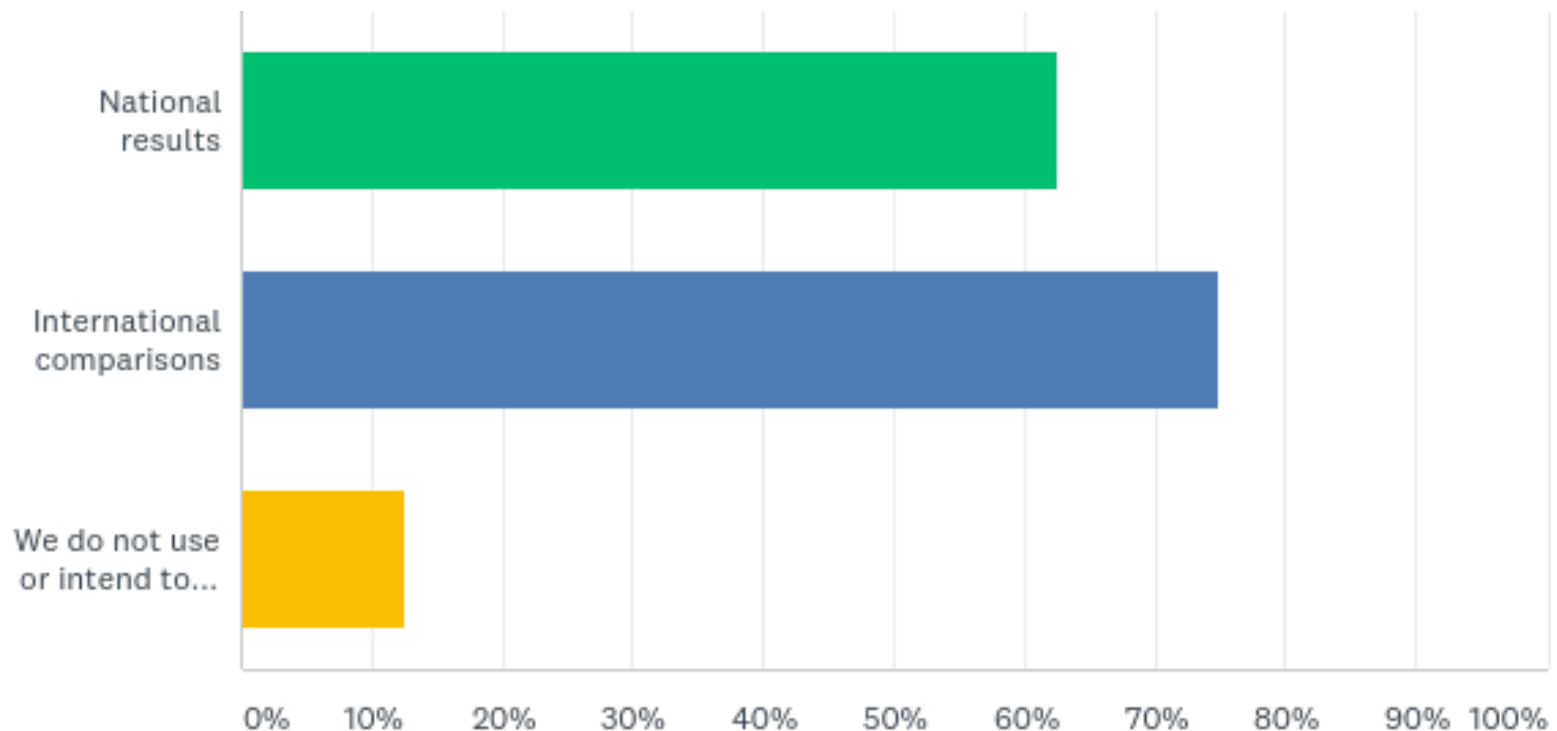
## Q12: Do you intend to use the Eurostat data on quality of employment in the future?

## Q14: If you have already consulted EUROBASE for data on quality of employment, is there anything that might improve the usability of the database?

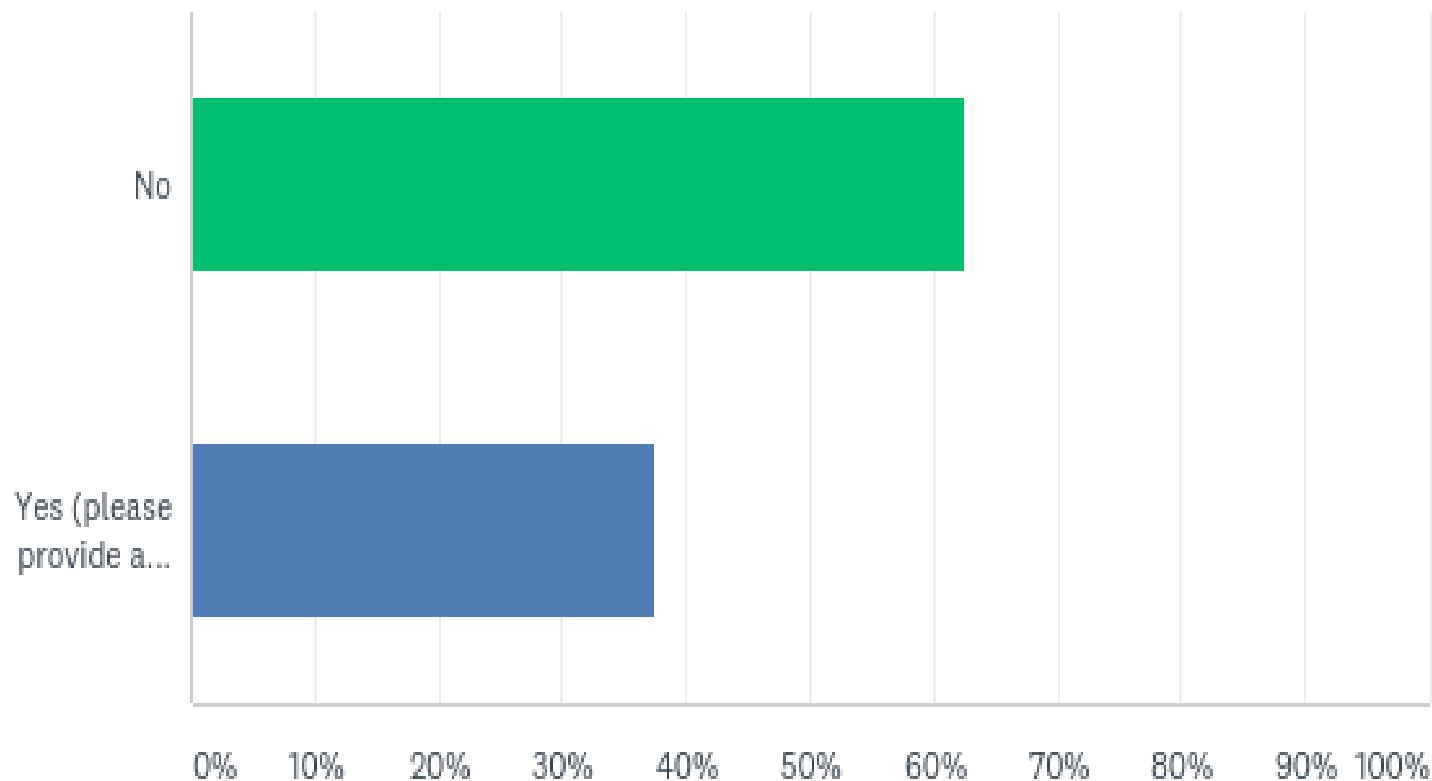


### STATISTICS
