Multidimensional poverty in Tajikistan

The presentation will be presented to the tasks in the short and medium-term prospects of the Agency for Statistics in cooperation with the main partner - the World Bank to expand the parameters of the household budget survey by conducting research module within the HBS. This approach, based on the index of multidimensional poverty for highly disaggregated information on poverty, employment, hunger, health, get more geographic targeting to assist the coverage of statistically "invisible" vulnerable groups. This approach provides multidimensional poverty index indicators for achievement of sustainable development goals, by income level, gender, age, affiliation, migration status, disability, place of residence and other criteria in accordance with the Fundamental Principles of Official Statistics (Resolution 68/261 of the UN General Assembly) and the objectives set in the National Development Strategy until 2030.
