

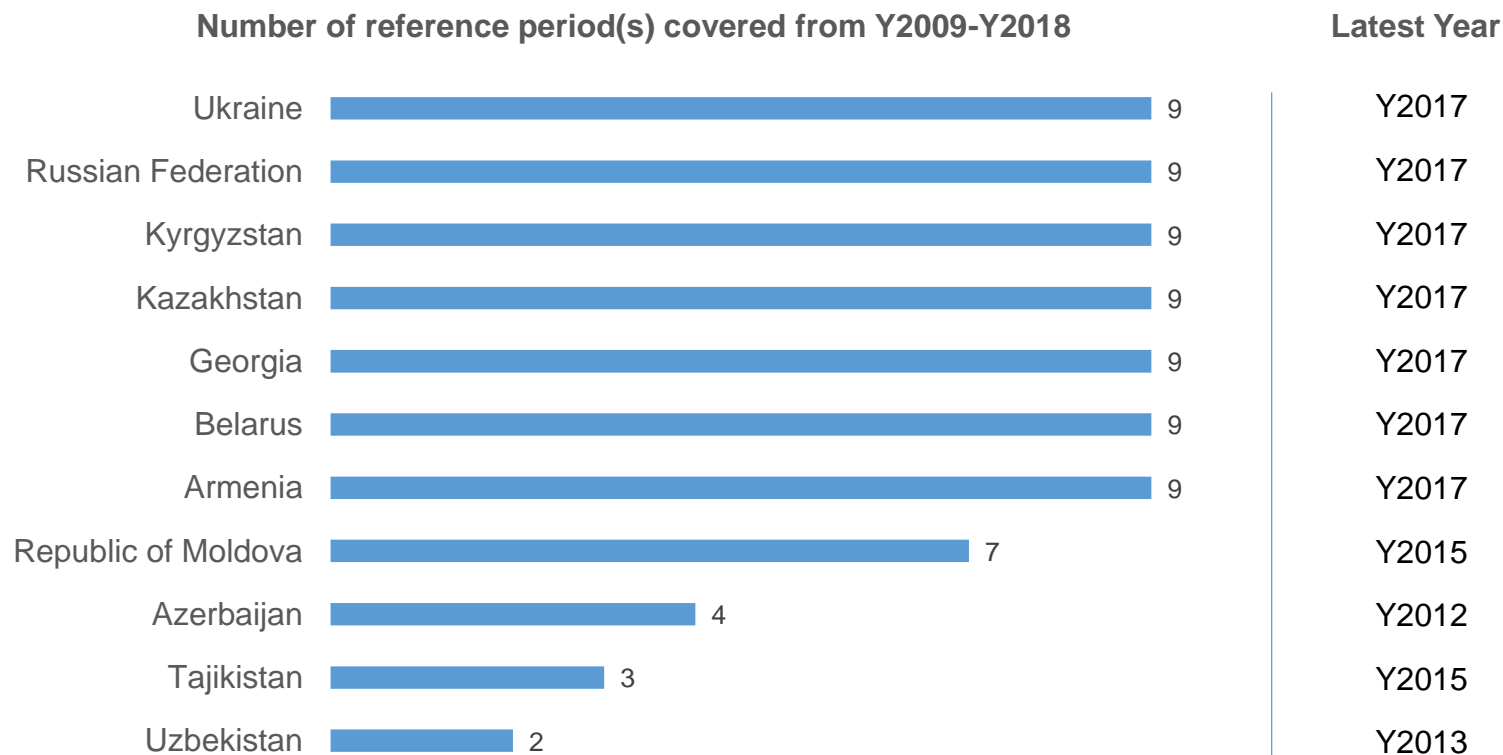


1.2.1 – Population living below national poverty line
