<p>Household income distribution map is an experimental statistic carried out by Spanish national statistical office (INE) that aims to release both level and distribution income indicators at a municipality scope as well as its administrative sub-areas. This publication results from a linkage between population and annual taxes registers and is presented by means of tables and an interactive map viewer which friendly shows core information to analyze income, poverty and social inequality.</p> <p><i>So far, level indicators published consist on total mean income per person and household while income distribution information is related to the type of source of income as well as information about the percentage of population with equivalised income below certain relative and absolute thresholds. Latter indicators can be found in a detailed breakdown of the main demographic variables such as genre, group of age and nationality. In the near future is planned to include new inequality measures as Gini indices and the income quintile share ratio (S80/S20 ratio).</i></p>
