Data collection of Integrated sample survey of household budget and labor force

Personal interview
(Traditional interview)



Telephone interviews

- Reducing the risk of spreading COVID-19
- Continued data collection under strict quarantine

- Large volume of questionnaires
- A one-time survey of the use of time budget was conducted on a reduced sample (4,700 respondents)
- Difficulties associated with getting to the households
- Conducting interviews in several steps

Additional surveys

1. Impact of COVID-19 on households

National Statistical Committee in October 2020 launched the module Impact of COVID-19 on households

- The purpose of the survey is to provide official statistics on the impact of COVID-19 on the living standards of households in the Kyrgyz Republic.

The survey was conducted by telephone among the Integrated Sample Survey of Household Budget and Labor Force respondents. Time for filling out the questionnaire 10 minutes

- The survey was conducted by Integrated Sample Survey of Household Budget and Labor Force supervisors.

The survey involved 4,954 households

Additional surveys

2. Web survey of the impact of COVID-19 on households

On October 27, 2020, the National Statistical Committee launched an experimental Web survey on the impact of COVID-19 on households among users of the official website of the National Statistical Committee

The link to the web survey was posted on the official website of the National Statistical Committee, and also disseminated through the media

Purpose of the web survey was to evaluate the use of web surveys for statistical purposes

To date, **960** site users have taken part in the survey

Problem: Calculating weighting factors to generate totals

3. Impact of COVID-19 on the situation of children and women in the Kyrgyz Republic

In September 2020, the National Statistical Committee, with the support of UNICEF, launched a one-time survey of the Impact of COVID-19 on the situation of children and women in the Kyrgyz Republic. The survey is based on the COMP-2018/MICS6 sample.

Goal 1.

- Listing Update - Collecting Phone Numbers for Telephone Surveys (7,200 households)
- Obtaining information on the impact of COVID-19 on the situation of children and women in the Kyrgyz Republic. The survey will provide data on the situation in households in the context of a pandemic, on the provision of social protection, personal well-being of household members, development in early childhood, distance education of children, parental participation in education, maternal and newborn health, postnatal care (4,310 households).

Goal 2

- Obtaining a sampling frame for the Integrated Sample Survey of Household Budget and Labor Force and other surveys of the living standards of the population for 2021-2022.

Work with interviewers and supervisors in a pandemic

1. Online training was conducted for supervisors and interviewers on the Zoom platform;
2. A number of trainings were carried out on the Zoom platform for conducting surveys:
 - Impact of COVID-19 on households
 - Impact of COVID-19 on the situation of children and women in the Kyrgyz Republic
3. Testing the technique of conducting surveys using the Zoom platform;
4. Checking the quality of the collected data (quality tables - twice a week).

Conclusions

- ▶ During the strict quarantine in the country, data collection on Integrated Sample Survey of Household Budget and Labor Force was not interrupted.
- ▶ The use of KAPI technologies and a telephone survey made it possible to carry out the work as planned.
