The Challenge, the Approach and the Benefit



- The impact of globalisation through MNE Groups
 the single largest "measurement" challenge facing producers of economic statistics
- → Beneficial to establish a unit in NSIs to deal with MNE Groups where such groups are significant
- → A multi-skilled team would ensure:
 - timely collection of data
 - use of accurate and coherent data from the beginning
 - prompt reaction to data changes
 - resolution of anomalies before processed by statistics




Large cases / consistency / international business – unit



- Should manage data & relations with MNE Groups
- Organisationally close to where data are collected or be responsible for data collection of MNE Groups
- Should adopt an account management approach with the MNE Groups – customer relationships
- Should improve the quality, consistency and coherency of data at the national level
- Should carry out data sharing, data exchange and data reconciliation with other NSIs

International aspects



- It is important to understand MNE Groups' structure and their ownership chain internationally
- This requires cooperation and exchange of relevant information between the concerned NSIs
- Several on-going international initiatives
- An international network of LCUs would facilitate the necessary exchange of information and experience



Network of LCUs



- Requested by over 60 Heads of NSIs in the Conference of European Statisticians (CES)
- Network would consist of the representatives of all existing LCUs + other experts of MNE Groups data
- First tasks of the network:
 - Nominate a focal point to the network
 - Comment on the LCU paper and apply as relevant
 - Provide input to the guidance on data sharing
 - Organize a one day seminar as part of the next meeting of the Group of Experts on National Accounts, April 2019
- UNECE to provide the secretariat to the LCU network
