
§10.86 Travel credits cover goods and services for own use or to give away acquired from an economy by nonresidents during visits to that economy. Travel debits cover goods and services for own use or to give away acquired from other economies by residents during visits to these other economies.

- etc.







Variable Type of Terminal: A payment card can be used in different terminals





Variable Type of Transaction: In each type of terminal many type of operations can be performed

Account information Pay tax Cash withdrawal Pay bills Change the pin code






Variables Card's Country & Terminal's Country: Country of the card: residency of the card issuer Assumption: card holder's residency ≈ card issuer's residency

Variable MCC: Merchant Category Code associated to the merchant where the POS is located Some "cards networks use a MCC to identify the type of business conducted by the merchant"

Cross-country comparisons

(Committee on Monetary, Financial and Balance of Payments Statistics Task-Force main conclusions)

- Payment card data gets more and more useful to supplement other data sources
- Since 2007 the discussion has started to identify and to gather information on the needs and availability of card data
- Current use: 13 countries use payment card data for national bop purposes (mostly to compile travel, the geographical breakdown for the travel item, transport, goods, services, ecommerce / also used for forecasting and oversight purposes)
- Main gaps: misclassification, thresholds, series breaks, irregular updating, ...
- Additional needs: a higher frequency, additional breakdown by merchant code, further geographical breakdown, ...





Future Challenges:

- Ongoing cooperation with Payment Systems Department on the identification of new entities that establish ATM and POS terminals in the national territory
- Pay attention to the residency of the entity that owns the POS terminal (foreign terminals in national territory, national terminals in foreign countries; cross-check with the issuing country of the card used)
- Monitor the evolution in the means of payment





- Credit side only; monthly data
- Capture the evolution of the value of accommodation services provided to foreign visitors:
 - Monthly revenue of accommodation services
 - Number of nights in tourist accommodation establishments, by country of origin of foreign tourists
- Challenge: coverage of the new forms of accommodation (e.g. Airbnb)
