
# Inclusive Data Charter, 2018

- Data to Leave No One Behind

- Principles

- 1) All populations must be **included** in the data.
- 2) All data should, wherever possible, be **disaggregated** to accurately describe all populations.
- 3) Data should be drawn from all **available sources**.
- 4) Those responsible for the collection of data and production of statistics must be **accountable**.
- 5) Human and technical **capacity** to collect, analyze, and use disaggregated data must be improved, including through adequate and sustainable financing.




# Disaggregation by ethnicity


Children in residential care (2016)

- **Planned: 2** UAC shelters with total **80** places


#### SIL (Supported Independent Living) apartments

- **Current: 10** Safe Zones for UAC with total **300** places



# Disaggregation by sex


Number of children who entered pre-sentence detention (during the year), 2016


# Disaggregation by Wealth Quintile

# Disaggregation by Education


Percentage of women aged 20 to 24 years who were first **married or in union** before age 18
