- First VNR draft prepared

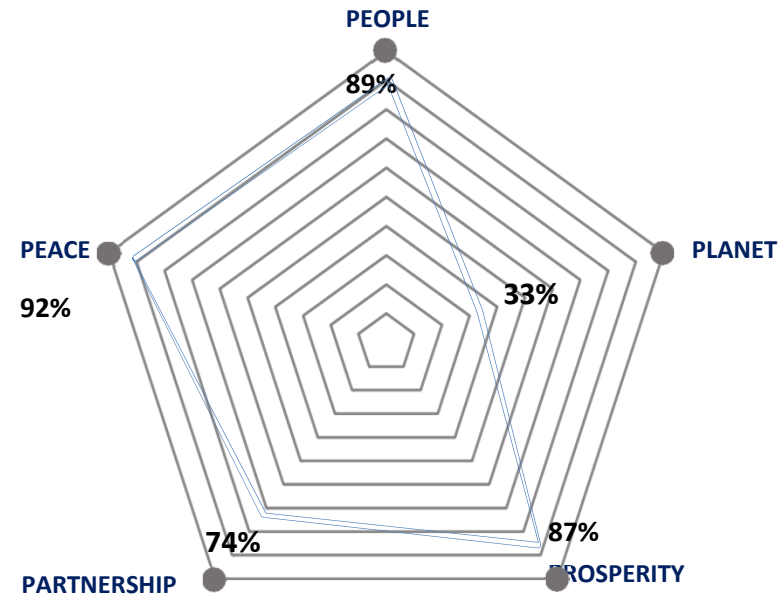

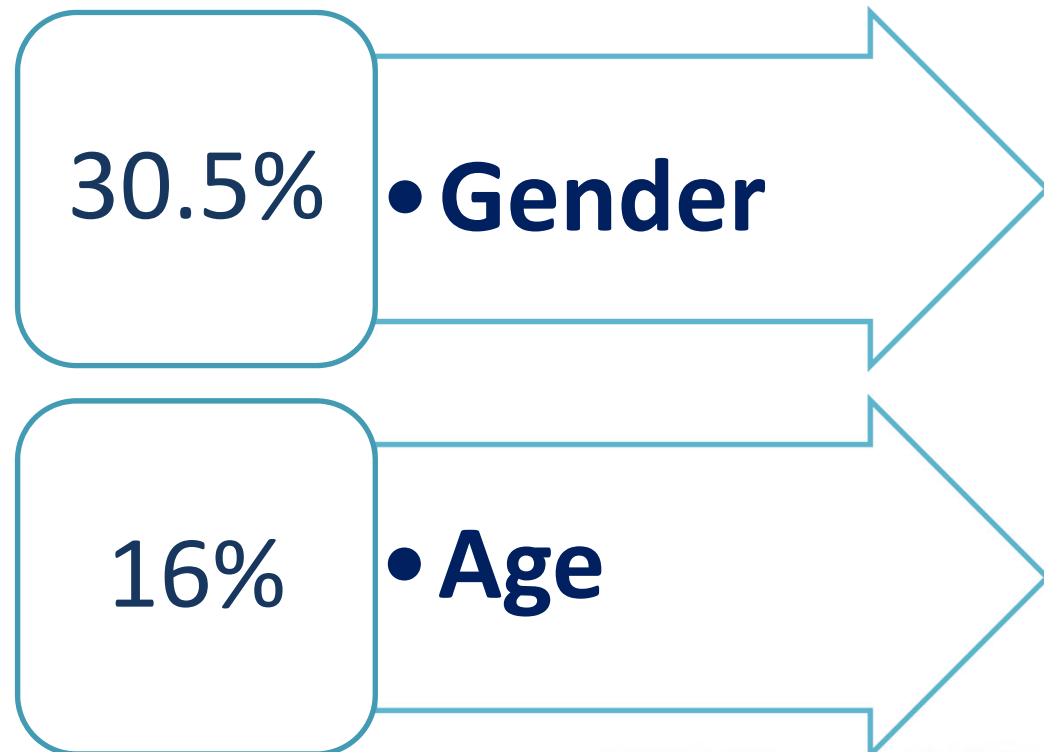
National Policies Priorities and Data Disaggregation



Advancement of children, women and the elderly– key areas of social policies

➤ Gender inequality is found in many areas: decision making, entrepreneurship, labour market, etc.

➤ Children and the elderly comprise almost half of the total population, and are vulnerable due to age specifics



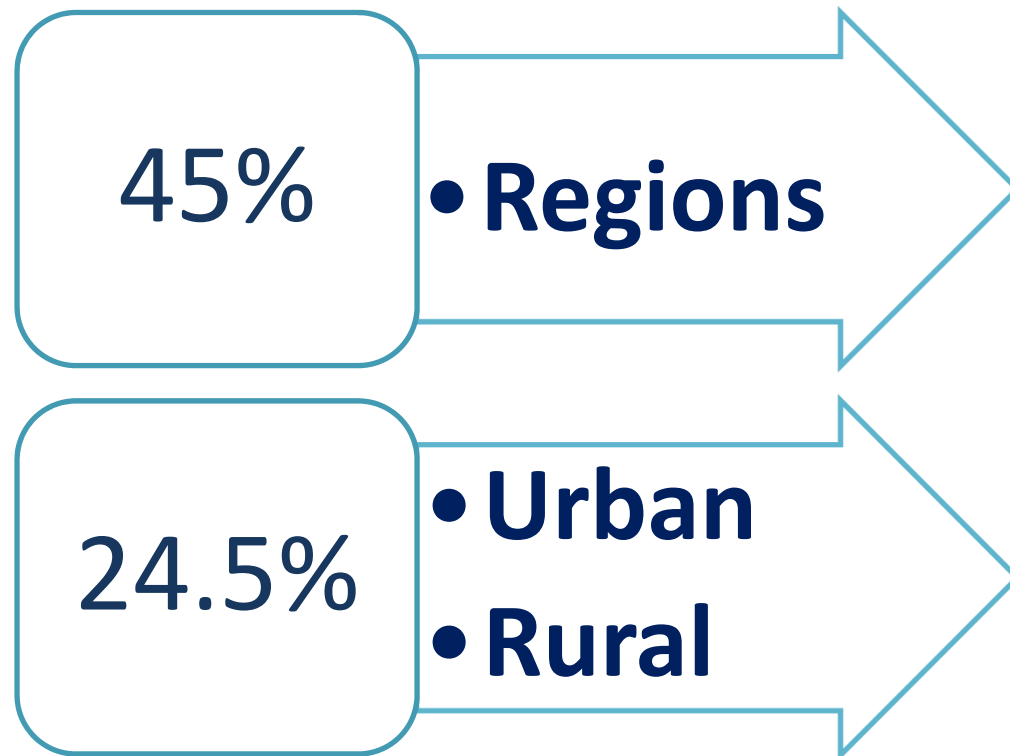


National Policies Priorities and Data Disaggregation

National Policies Priorities and Data Disaggregation

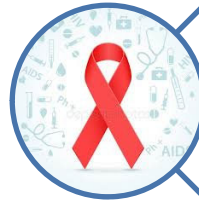


Improvement of quality of life and advancement of vulnerable groups (disabled, PLWHA, refugees and migrants) – priority categories
