



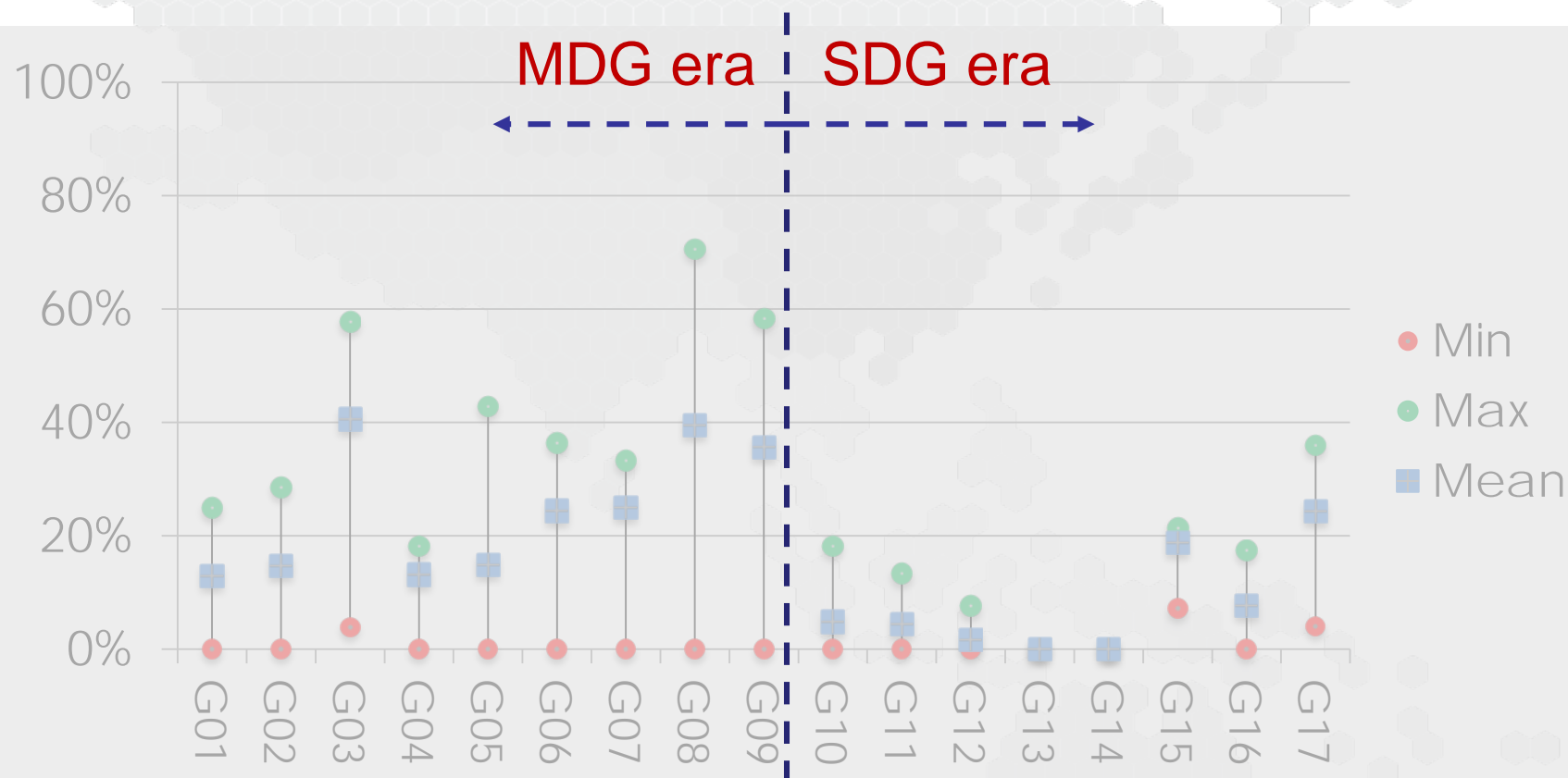

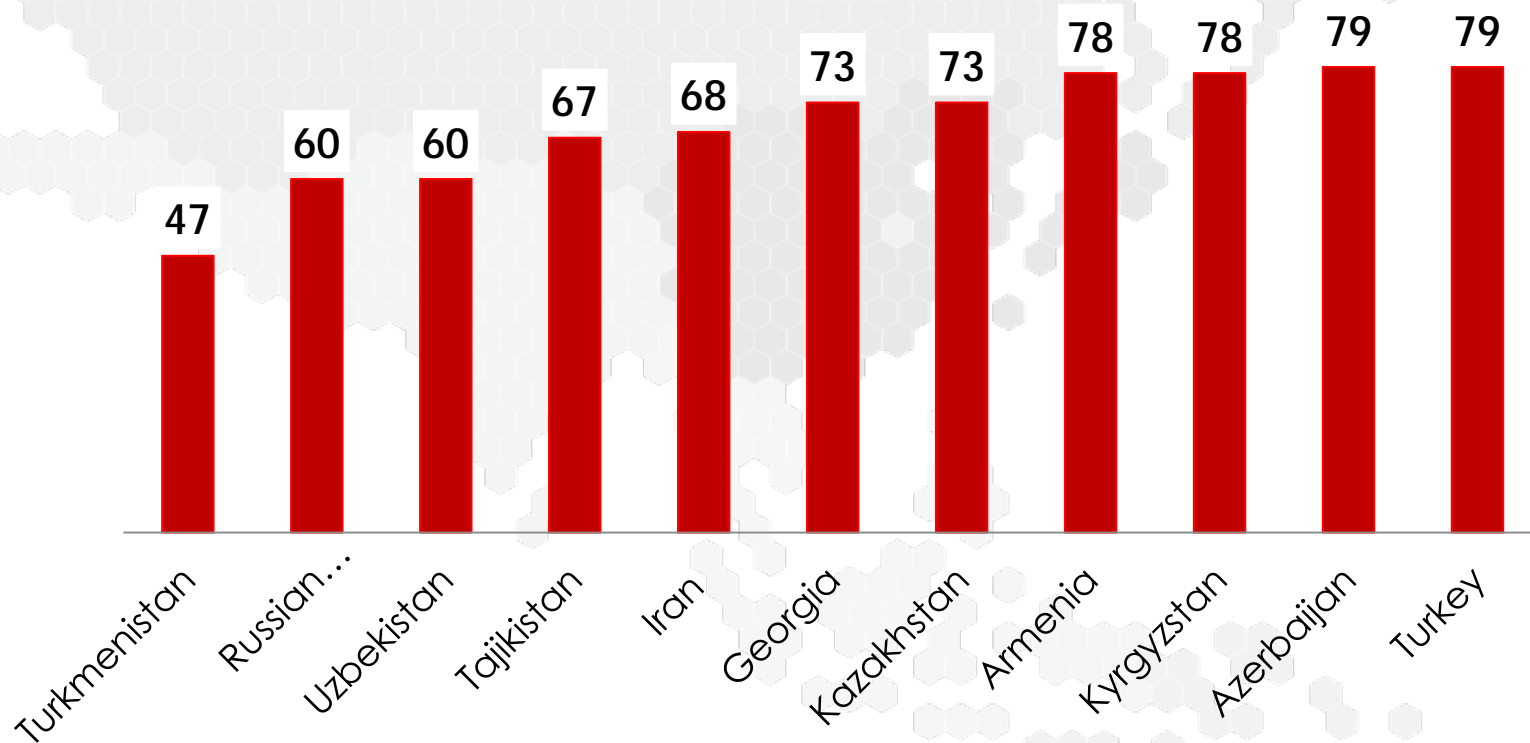

The vision: We, the Asia-Pacific statistical community share the vision that

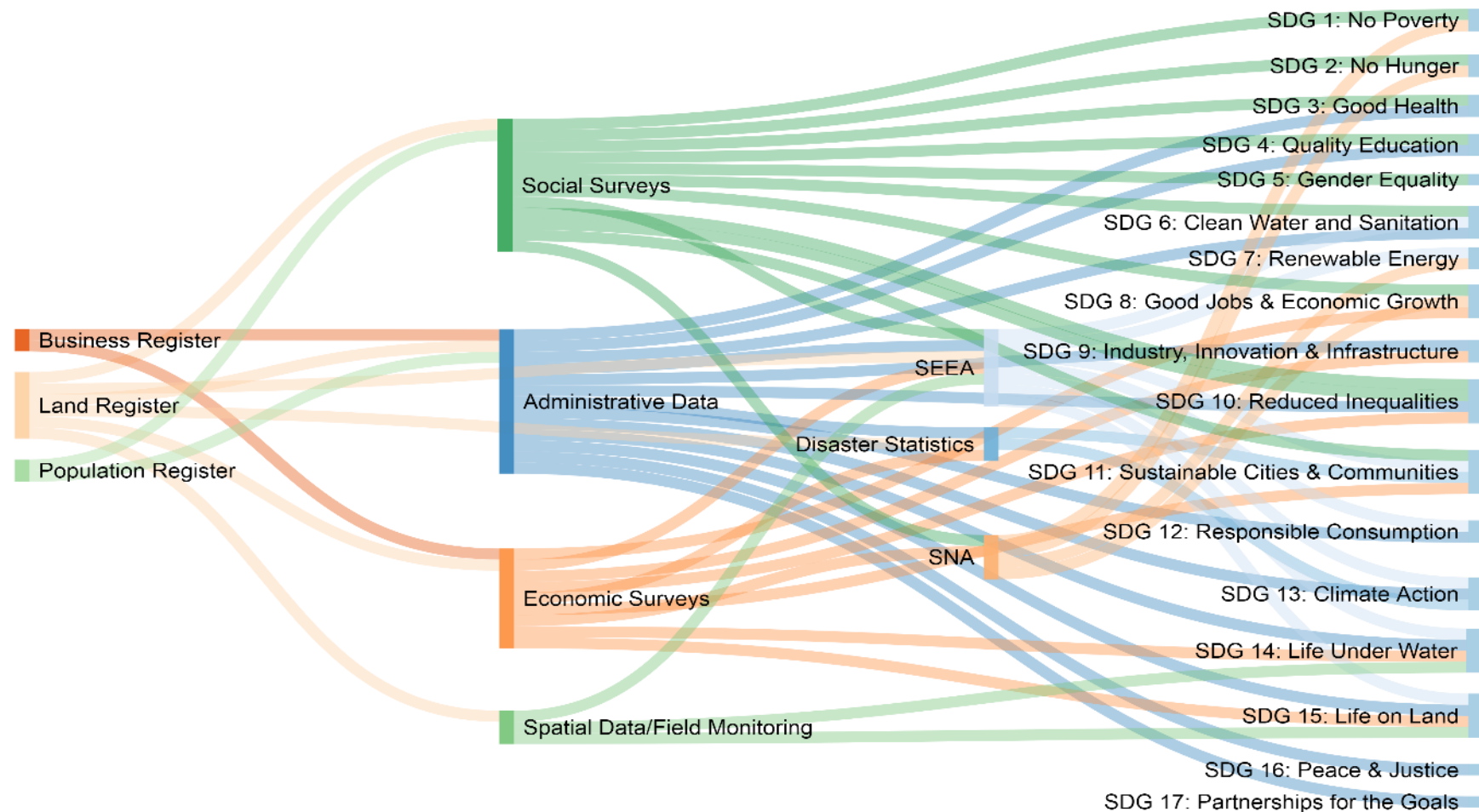
