
## Official Statistics in a Federal System

- Germany consists of 16 federal states (Länder).
- The 14 statistical offices of the "Länder" are autonomous.
- Federal and Land statistical offices jointly produce federal statistics.




14 Land Statistical Offices (LSO)

is a strategic programme for the further development of official statistics in Germany.


manages the joint modernisation activities of the Federal and States Statistical Offices.

aims to make the quality of the statistical products and services future-proofed through the improvement of the production processes.

is called "Master"-Plan because it coordinates several subplans as a comprehensive plan.



#### The Masterplan uniform processes → increased efficiency cutted burden


