

# Highlights of the Review

- "Wood energy policies and markets reshaping entire forest sector" – main title
- UNECE region consumption of wood and paper products at record volumes in 2006
- US housing construction decline drags down North American forest products markets
- Stronger European and CIS markets





- Government policies accelerate wood energy
- Industry demand for wood increasing
- Mobilization of more wood affects entire sector
  - Short-term consequences
  - Long-term opportunities
- Focus of Wednesday's Policy Forum too





- Certified forest area reaches almost 300 million ha
- Most in UNECE region
- Not only forests and wood products certified
  - Wood fuel
  - Non-wood forest products





- China leads world in roundwood imports
- China leads world in furniture exports
- Stimulates UNECE region trade
  - Export destination
  - Import source, with localized effects






# Highlights by subregion (continued)



- New Forest
- Aims to
- Rising export taxes on roundwood
- Start-up complications









- North America
  - Weak production and trade
  - Weak prices
  - Imports decrease
  - Off shore exports increase
  - US-Canada Softwood Lumber Agreement resolved...





# Highlights of the *Review* (final)

- Europe
  - Strong growth in sawn softwood production, consumption
  - Log shortage resolved with higher prices & storm
  - Sawnwood prices escalating
  - Production capacity increases with demand
  - German softwood production up 12% in 2006
     and roundwood production up 9%.
