INDUSTRY IN YUGOSLAVIA

Since the second session of the Timber Sub-Committee, the Executive Secretary of the Economic Commission for Europe has received from the Government of the People's Federative Republic of Yugoslavia, a note containing the following particulars completing the figures and information relating to Yugoslav exports:

"1. The normal exports from Yugoslavia of sawn softwood for 1948 amount to 60,000 standards.

2. Supplementary exports, provided the credit is obtained, will amount to:

(a) 80,000 m.³ of pitwood.

(b) 100,000 standards of sawn softwood.

This means that Yugoslavia is increasing the production and supplementary export of sawn softwood announced at the second session of the Sub-Committee from 60,000 to 100,000 standards.

In spite of this increase, Yugoslavia is not insisting on a corresponding increase in the credit allotted by the Timber Sub-Committee on the basis of the exportation of the 60,000 standards of sawn softwood only."
