ToRs of the Joint FAO/UNECE Working Party on Forest Statistics, Economics and Management

- The Working Party is a subsidiary body of the ECE Committee on Forests and the Forest Industry (COFFI) and the FAO European Forestry Commission (EFC)
- It takes instructions from the Committee and the Commission and meets annually to:
 - Provide guidance on implementing the PoW
 - Supervise the work of ToSs
 - Identify emerging issues; and suggest priorities and specific recommendations to the Committee and the Commission for consideration

ToRs cont.



- The Working Party shall, review and comment on the activities undertaken during the past year and the plans for the forthcoming year.
- The Working Party shall review, on an ongoing basis, the work of the Teams of Specialists
 - When needed, the Working Party may review and recommend updated mandates for the Teams for endorsement by the parent bodies;
 - Identify possible synergies; and facilitate the exchange of experiences between Teams and delegations from member States;
 - Increase the visibility and impact of the work of Teams of Specialists



The Working Party, as requested by the Committee and Commission, shall:

- Propose priorities for activities in the work areas and on relevant emerging issues
- Assist with methods for collecting, validating, analysing and disseminating information and statistics
- Undertake ad hoc projects in economics and statistics
- Provide technical advice to the Committee and the Commission on issues under consideration by those bodies
- Reach out to other sectors to discuss issues related to forest information and management matters of common interest
- Work together with other international and avoiding any duplication of effort
- This working party will be assessed after the next two sessions




Self-Assessment Process: around one question to be answered through a participatory exercise



Method used: **H form**




H-FORM





Form four groups based on the first letter of their first name (given name):


• A-L (e.g. Anna through Lauri) is group 1
