- desk studies for 15 countries





System for the Evaluation of the Management of Forests (SEMAFOR)






- The pilot implementation starts after the completion of the pan-European reporting

- requested by UNECE COFFI and FAO EFC at their joint session in Rovaniemi in December 2013
- prepared by a team of experts in close cooperation with the Joint Section
- countries have been consulted as regards the data
- the study was discussed in draft form at:
 - workshop organized in Geneva, October 2014
 - 72nd Session of UNECE COFFI in Kazan, November 2014.
- the draft was commented by countries (COFFI and EFC) in December 2014

 The electronic version will be released on 20 March 2015, during the celebrations of the International Day of Forests

 The presentation of the study and release of the printed version will be carried out at the 11th session of UNFF to be held in New York in May 2015.
