# Summary

# I. Implementation by the secretariat

# A. Major events

- 1. The work area on communication and outreach has encountered some challenges given that the related responsibilities were assigned to three different contract staff members in the past year, two of whom have left the UNECE. Nevertheless, there are substantial accomplishments which can be reported.
- 2. The UNECE/FAO Forestry and Timber Section (Joint Section) conducted outreach and communication for one major event since the last Working Party meeting: the 72nd Session of the Committee on Forests and the Forest Industry which took place in Kazan, Russian Federation in November, 2014.
- 3. The communication and outreach activities of the Kazan event focused on: the role of forests in mitigating climate change; the current status of forest products markets in the ECE region; and unfolding developments in the areas of wood energy, trade in forest products and the current growth of wood-based fabrics markets. Press releases covering these three items were released during the meeting in Kazan.
- 4. The next major event will be the celebration of the International Day of Forests 2015 (on 20 March), which will focus on the theme: Food for Forests Forests for Food. As the outreach and communication activities are ongoing, the results will be reported fully next year. The theme of the International Day of Forests in Geneva highlights one aspect of forests and their products in our daily life. The Joint Section is planning on the contribution of forests to health and wellbeing as a theme for the 2016 International Day of Forests.
- 5. Following the International Day of Forests 2015 event in March, the next major event requiring outreach and communication activities is the joint session of the UNECE Committee on Forests and the Forest Industry and the FAO European Forestry Commission called Silva2015. European Forest Week will be celebrated during Silva2015 with the theme "*The Value of Forests*". As the outreach and communication activities are ongoing, the results will be reported fully next year.

## B. Publications

- 6. Publications have been one of the primary tools of the Joint Section for knowledge sharing on a variety of forest related topics and for reaching out to a more technical and specialized audiences. These publications are useful for strengthening political and technical capacity in the forest sector and in contributing to sustainable development throughout the UNECE region. Publications also promote the work of the Joint Section.
- 7. Numerous study papers and discussion papers were published last year and more are in the pipeline for the next twelve months. One important publication to note is the UNECE/FAO publication entitled "Forests in the ECE Region: Trends and Challenges in Achieving the Global Objectives on Forests". It will be launched during the International Day of Forests and presented at the 11th Session of the United Nations Forum on Forests. - 8. The Joint Section also produced the Rovaniemi Action Plan as a publication. A publication format makes the Action Plan more visible and user friendly than the meeting document ECE/TIM/2013/2–FO:EFC/2013/2.
- 9. The theme of the international day of forests 2014 was "Forests for Fashion, Fashion for Forests When sustainable forest management meets sustainable fashion trends". The Joint Section, in collaboration with Cittadellarte Fondazione Pistoletto, will soon publish a short information brochure about the event.

# C. Press releases/expert opinions on the UNECE/FAO website

- 10. In addition to the press releases leading up to and during the Committee meeting in Kazan, Russian Federation, two press releases were issued since the last Working Party: one on forests in the Green Economy, with the title "The Green Economy: a real goal or just an excuse to promote forests?" the other on the continued increase of the forest area in the ECE Region; however, it highlighted the threat that urban sprawl poses towards slowing or stopping this trend.
- 11. The Joint Section press releases have been picked up and shared by other international and regional organizations and have been used as the basis of web- and paper-based news reports. ### D. Other media

12. The Joint Section is producing an infographic to display some of the findings of the UNECE/FAO report entitled Forests in the ECE region: Trends and Challenges in Achieving the Global Objectives on Forests. The infographic is expected to be launched at the International Day of Forests 2015 celebrations and shared through the Section's and other relevant networks.

#### E. Billboard

- 13. The Forest Information Billboard was launched in 2014, as an open forum to share developments on forest information (data and statistics) and forest reporting (global, regional and national processes), including advances in reporting as well as forest related or forest relevant projects, publications and events.
- 14. Four issues of the Forest Information Billboard were published at the UNECE/FAO website in 2014, and a similar schedule will continue throughout 2015 (March, June, September, and December). The number of contributions varied between 11 to 22 short articles in each issue in 2014 with an average of 16, compared to 8-17 short articles and an average of 13 in 2013. # F. Articles and external publications

15. The Joint section has been active in sharing knowledge by contributing to external publications. This ranged from refereeing publications to contributions to publications as contributing authors. For a more comprehensive list of journal articles and contributions to books, please see Annex B.

# G. Web statistics

- 16. The ECE website was redesigned in late 2014 to make it more attractive and user-friendly. A section on country-specific documents was also added.
- 17. Page views declined in 2014 to approximately 115,000. This was higher than the 2012 level but lower than the 2013 level. Overall, there seems to be an absolute decline as well as a decline relative to the rest of the ECE, as the share of total UNECE page views declined by 1.5% in 2013 and 1.3% in 2014.
- 18. The Data and Statistics page again increased its share of the Timber and Forestry programme's page views to 11% and is now the most visited page after our home page. More detailed information is available in annex C, including for the first time the leading files downloaded.

## H. Major external meetings

- 19. The Joint Section participated in numerous meetings, workshops and conferences since the last Working Party meeting, delivering presentations and key note speeches. This is important for the Section's outreach strategy to communicate and disseminate its work and expertise to different sectors. This increases access to a network of partners and assists the section in staying abreast of trends and developments affecting the forest sector.

# I. Team of Specialists on Forest Communication (Forest Communicators' Network)

21. There were no formal meetings on the ToS since the last Working Party meeting. However, a core group will provide communications related input to the secretariat for the preparations of the joint session of the COFFI and the EFC - Silva 2015. The core group met for this purpose for the first time from 26-27 February 2015 in Engelberg, Switzerland. The objective of the meeting was to discuss the communications needs for Silva2015 and the engagement of partners and sponsors in European Forest Week. More information will be provided at the Working Party meeting as this paper was finalized before the outcome of the meeting was available.

## J. Key questions for guidance and discussion

- 22. The Working Party is invited to:
  - a. Consider providing suggestions for the activities of the European Forest Week 2015 that will be held in Engelberg/Switzerland from 2 to 6 November 2015.
  - b. Provide feedback to the suggestion of "Forests for health and wellbeing" as theme for the International Day of Forests 2016.
  - c. Consider commenting on major events and communication achievements in the past year, and provide guidance on how to further improve the activities in this work area.
