
## United States Pledge

- In 2012, US pledged 15 million ha to Bonn Challenge
- By 2018, 17 million ha under restoration by USDA Forest Service and partners





## United States Context




### Restoration Context

- Success factors
  - Strong governance
  - Relatively stable forest estate
- Challenges
  - Degraded forest conditions due to
    - Fire exclusion
    - Insect and disease
    - Past poor management
  - Climate change makes this worse



# Work under Bonn Challenge

Figure 8.1 Area under restoration by FLR intervention types



#### Success Factors

- **Strong** governance
- Relatively stable forest estate
- Strong partnerships
- Policies supporting restoration
- Solid reporting infrastructure with flexibility for scale
- Monitoring and adaptive management

- Leveraging conservation finance opportunities
- Shifting from outputs to outcomes
- New policy opportunities
