

# **Item 6(c) of the provisional agenda, Reporting on Sustainable Forest Management in the Caucasus and Central Asia**

C&I development process in Kyrgyzstan



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- The Kyrgyz Republic belongs to sparsely wooded areas, forests are mainly represented by mountain plantations, are quite diverse and rich in valuable species. About 90% of the forests of the Kyrgyz Republic are located at an altitude of 700 to 3500 meters above sea level
- The forested area of the Kyrgyz Republic is 1,123.2 thousand hectares, or 5.6% of the total area of the country. The forested area assigned to the State Agency for Environmental Protection and Forestry under the Government of the Kyrgyz Republic is 846.0 thousand hectares, or 4.2%, outside the territory of the SFF and protected areas 277 thousand hectares or 1.4% (National Forest Inventory KR, 2008-2010).
- Forests of the Kyrgyz Republic are represented by four types: walnut-fruit, coniferous-spruce, juniper and floodplain. All forests are conservation





# PROJECT RESULTS

## National set of C&I

- Two National Seminars were held with the participation of all stakeholders
- Also, workshops were held at the local level with the participation of forestry representatives, tenants and the local population
- A pilot collection of information on the number and income of tenants was carried out by submitting statistical reports to the National Statistical Committee through district departments in the form of statistical reporting 2LH-tenant
- By processing the proposals received as a result of the discussions from the participants in the process, 6 criteria and 58 indicators were developed





- At the moment, work is underway to finalize C&I passports with the definition of data collection methods
  - The latest version of C&I will be presented for discussion to the departments of the Department of Forest Ecosystems Development
  - The final set of C&I will be submitted for approval by the order of the SAEPF
  - Indicators, the collection of data on which presents certain difficulties, may be reformulated or excluded
  - The possibility of a trial collection of data on some indicators selectively was considered.
  - The national set of C&I will be a kind of navigator with which you can determine the next steps in forest policy
