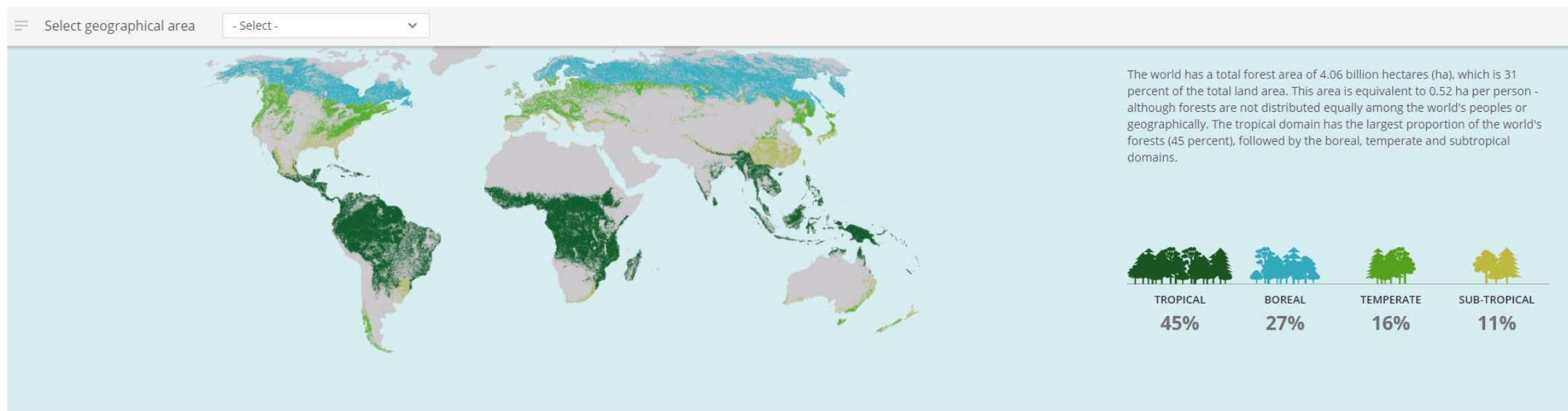

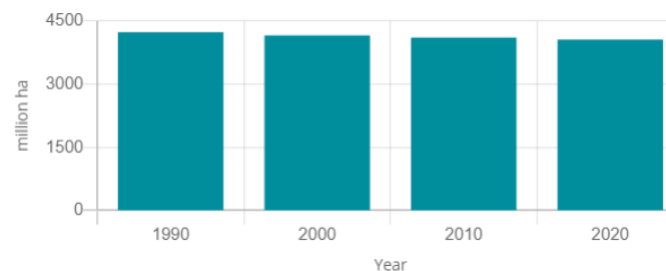

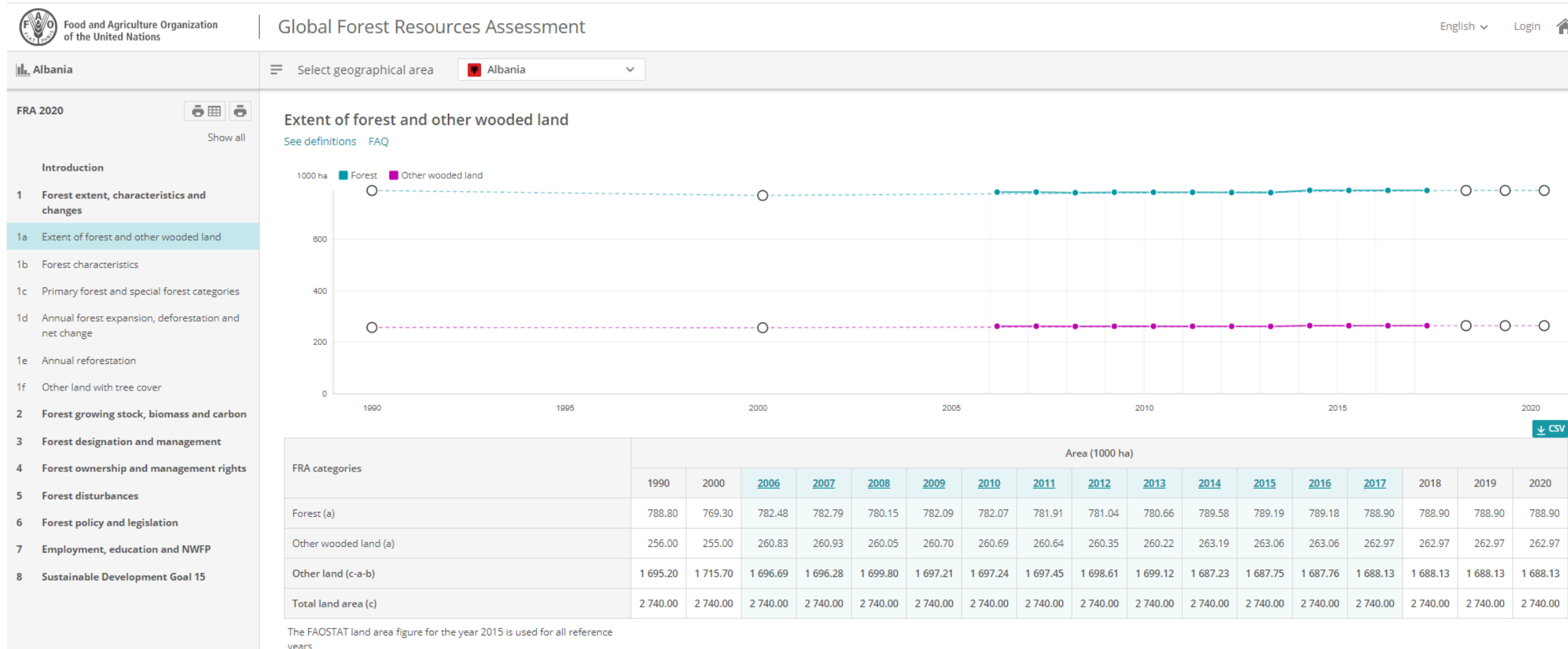


Primary forest % of forest area (2020)
