

How to Develop a Port Community System

Simple, efficient solutions for swift and smooth supply chains.

Port Community Systems provide for efficient electronic data exchanges between all stakeholders within a Port Community, from Port Authorities and Customs to Shipping Lines and Hauliers. However, many ports do not have an integrated Port Community System and therefore users have to input the same data into several different systems, duplicating work and creating inefficiencies.

In order to support the development of further Port Community Systems within Europe, EPCSA is launching a simplified Guide to the steps involved in developing a PCS. This Guide will be launched at the first Seminar in EPCSA's seminar programme on "How to Develop a Port Community System". To be held at the UNECE in Geneva on December 14, 2011, this Seminar will form part of the programme of the UNECE Single Window Conference, which takes place December 12-15, 2011.
