At its 2017 session, the Specialized Section decided to organize a practical workshop which was held on 4 May 2018 with the assistance of the International Nut and Dried Fruit Council (INC). (d) Dried melons

The Specialized Section is invited to review the proposed new standard for dried melons (coordination: Uzbekistan).

The Specialized Section is invited to discuss the possible development of a standard for dried berries.

In 2017, the Specialized Section adopted its first poster for dried apricots which has been published in English and Russian (and translated by users into Kyrgyz, Tajik and Uzbek languages). At its 2017 session, the Specialized Section also decided to develop posters for:

- (a) Inshell pistachio nuts;
- (b) Inshell walnuts;
- (c) Walnut kernels.
