Background

Central Asian Working Group to promote the export of agricultural products from the region agreed to coordinate with UNECE WG 7 the development of a new standard for dried Persimmons (September 25-26, 2019 Tashkent)



Definition of produce

Dried/sun-dried persimmons come from fresh persimmons of varieties (cultivars) originating from Diospyros kakiL., are supplied to consumers in dried form.



The composition and content of the produce

- up to 25% sucrose and glucose,
- provitamin A
- Apple acid,
- lemon acid,
- vitamin C,
- Vitamin P
- iron,
- calcium,
- copper,
- manganese
- potassium



1.Persimmon is one of the main fruit crops in the Central Asian countries, the production of persimmons only in Uzbekistan and Tajikistan in 2018 reached more than 80 thousand tons.
