1. Adoption of the agenda

2. Matters arising since the last session

(a) United Nations, United Nations Economic Commission for Europe and subsidiary bodies

The secretariat will present developments at the United Nations, the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE) and the Steering Committee on Trade Capacity and Standards having an impact on the work of the Working Party on Agricultural Quality Standards (WP.7). The Working Party is invited to adopt its programme of work for 2019-2020 and request the renewal of its mandate for a five-year period from 2019 to 2023.

3. Sustainable Development Goals and the work under the Working Party on Agricultural Quality Standards – Updates

Delegations are invited to provide updates on their countries' initiatives on the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) as well as discussions that have taken place at each Specialized Section session in 2018. The secretariat will provide further information prior to the session.

4. Revision of the Terms of Reference of the Working Party

At the 2017 session and in the absence of written contributions on the revision of its Terms of Reference, the Working Party formed an open working group consisting of Germany,

Poland, Switzerland, United States and the secretariat to prepare a written proposal for discussion. Delegations are invited to review the first proposal of revised Terms of Reference for WP.7.

5. Revision of the Working Procedures of the Working Party

At its 2017 session, the Working Party had reviewed several proposals on procedures for handling, during the revision of standards, reservations placed by countries often a long time ago. The Working Party agreed to ask a working group (Belgium, Germany, Poland, Slovakia, Switzerland and the United States) to develop a step-by-step procedure and compile all proposals in one document for comments. Delegations are invited to review the new proposals.

6. Capacity-building and promotional activities

The secretariat will review all capacity-building activities under the new United Nations Development Account 11 project which started in January 2018. Delegations will exchange information on capacity-building, training and promotional activities that have taken place since the last session of WP.7 or are planned for the near future.

7. Electronic quality certificates for fresh fruit and vegetables

The Secretariat will give a brief update about the discussions at the May 2018 session of the Specialized Section on Fresh Fruit and Vegetables and in the United Nations Centre for Trade Facilitation and Electronic Business (UN/CEFACT) on the development of an electronic quality certificate for fresh fruit and vegetables.

8. Specialized Section on Standardization of Meat

The Specialized Section held one regular session as well as an international symposium on sustainable international e-trade for meat.
