EUROPEAN AGREEMENT SUPPLEMENTING THE 1949 CONVENTION ON
ROAD TRAFFIC AND THE 1949 PROTOCOL ON ROAD SIGNS AND SIGNALS

GENEVA, 16 SEPTEMBER 1950

LIECHTENSTEIN: ACCESSION

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary,
communicates the following:

The above action was effected on 2 March 2020, with:

Declaration (Original: English)

Declaration with regard to Art. 1 Convention on Road Traffic and annex 1

“The Principality of Liechtenstein does not consider itself bound by the supplementary point concerning annex 1 of the Convention on Road Traffic in accordance with its declaration to the Convention on Road Traffic concluded in Geneva on 19 September 1949 regarding the exclusion of the application of annex 1 to the Principality of Liechtenstein.”

The Agreement shall enter into force for Liechtenstein on 2 June 2021¹ in accordance with its article 4 (1) which reads as follows:

“This Agreement shall enter into force at the time of the entry into force of the Convention and Protocol of 19 September 1949, referred to in article 1, on condition that three of the States Parties to the said Convention and Protocol shall have become Parties to the Agreement.”
