EUROPEAN AGREEMENT SUPPLEMENTING THE CONVENTION ON ROAD
TRAFFIC OPENED FOR SIGNATURE AT VIENNA ON 8 NOVEMBER 1968
GENEVA, 1 MAY 1971

LIECHTENSTEIN: ACCESSION

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary,
communicates the following:

The above action was effected on 2 March 2020, with:

Reservation, declaration and notification (Original: English)

“Reservation with regard to the annex, item 7 ad Article 8 of the Convention, paragraph 5

The Principality of Liechtenstein does not consider itself bound by the additional paragraph to be inserted immediately after paragraph 5 of article 8 of the Convention.

Declaration with regard to the reservations made under the Convention on Road Traffic

The relevant reservations of the Principality of Liechtenstein on the Convention on Road Traffic also apply to this Agreement.

Notification with regard to Art. 6, paragraph 8

The Agreement shall enter into force for Liechtenstein on 2 March 2021 in accordance with its article 4(2) which reads as follows:

"For each State ratifying, or acceding to, this Agreement after the deposit of the tenth instrument of ratification or accession, the Agreement shall enter into force twelve months after the date of deposit by such State of its instrument of ratification or accession."
