### TRANSPORT OF GASES

Comments on document ST/SG/AC.10/C.3/2005/26 from EIGA

#### **Introduction**

Belgium agrees with the principle behind the proposal of EIGA and prefers the second option. But the text can be simplified because part of the proposed new “n” is already in “k” and should not be repeated.

Belgium proposes that the second proposal from EIGA should read as follows:

“n: Cylinders, individual cylinders in a bundle and assemblies (groups) of cylinders containing UN 1045 Fluorine, compressed (see special packing provision ‘k’) shall contain not more than 5 kg of the gas.  
“
