Thank you Mr. Chairman,

WHO agrees with this paper. However, to capture the intents of this proposal, we would like to propose the following text for 2.6.3.6.2:

“Carcasses of animals infected with pathogens classified in Category A and not carrying the mention ‘culture only’ shall be assigned to UN 2814 or UN 2900 as appropriate.

Carcasses of animals infected with pathogens classified in Category B shall be transported in accordance with provisions determined by the competent authority”.
