LISTING, CLASSIFICATION AND PACKING

Comments on ST/SG/AC.10/C.3/2007/3

Submitted by the International Council of Chemical Associations (ICCA)

Having received a number of comments from other delegations on its proposal regarding the classification of substances specifically listed by name in the Dangerous Goods List, ICCA proposes to replace the text of the first part of its proposal i.e. paragraph 6 (a), by the following

(a) Insert a new paragraph 2.0.1.6

“2.0.1.6 Substances specifically listed by name in the Dangerous Goods List in Chapter 3.2, are not subject to these Regulations if

- (a) their chemical or physical properties are such that they do not meet the criteria for inclusion in the class or division listed for them in column (3) of the Dangerous Goods List or in any other class or division; and
- (b) there is no other reason, such as Special Provision 279 (human experience), to use the assigned classification.”

This new text is an editorial improvement only, and does not intend to modify the content of the proposal.

The rest of the proposed text for amendments, listed in ST/SG/AC.10/C.3/2007/3, remains unchanged.
