UN Composite IBC Correspondence Working Group

### Terms of reference

A Correspondence Group coordinated by the expert of the United Kingdom, and including representatives of affected industries and users of intermediate bulk containers (IBC's), shall examine current practices of UN composite IBC re-bottling and cross bottling in several countries. This examination shall include consideration of the application of relevant parts of the Model Regulations, as well as test information, accidents, guidance materials, standards, and methods used by manufacturers, users, repairer and remanufacturer of IBC's to assure quality and production of compliant packaging.

The Correspondence Group shall report to the Sub-Committee, and may make recommendations for clarification of the Model Regulations, and revisions to composite IBC marking provisions, as appropriate.
