5.4.1.1.2 Transport document for tank vessels

Transmitted by the Government of Austria^{1,2}

1. It is proposed to replace the following text under 5.4.1.1.2:

"Examples of such permitted dangerous goods descriptions are:

**"UN 1230 METHANOL, 3 (6.1), II", or
"UN 1230 METHANOL, 3 (6.1), PG II"**.

with the text

"Examples of such permitted dangerous goods descriptions are:

**"UN 1203 MOTOR SPIRIT, 3 (N2, CMR, F), II" or
"UN 1203 MOTOR SPIRIT, 3 (N2, CMR, F), PG II"**.

Background

2. Table C often contains more than two dangers in column 5. For example the entry for UN 1203 Motor Spirit lists "3+N2+CMR+F". The current example does not explain, whether the correct entry in the transport document is

"UN 1203 MOTOR SPIRIT, 3 (N2, CMR, F), II" or
"UN 1203 MOTOR SPIRIT, 3 (N2+CMR+F), II"

3. An example with more than two dangers would provide clearer information.
