

Measures to be taken by Iran's Customs in transit procedure

1. Installation and operation of world ASYCUDA System.
2. Installation of electronic system for data exchanging.
3. Establishment and joint utilization of data terminals with relevant organizations and agencies.
4. Improving, equipping and mobilization of customs in transit procedure.
5. Increasing customs proficiency to make use of security equipment and facilities in entrance and exit points such as x-ray scanners machines.
6. Attempting to establish single-window system.
7. Entrusting the customs with the responsibilities of other organizations.
8. Utilization of data bank of transportation companies.
