Your Excellency,

The Ministry of Transport of the Republic of Latvia (hereinafter – Ministry of Transport) has the honour to inform you, that the Republic of Latvia has accepted the ECE Inland Transport Committee Working Party on Inland Water Transport Resolution No. 40 "International Certificate for Operators of Pleasure Craft" (hereinafter – Resolution No. 40).

Minimum standards for pleasure craft operators' training and certification in accordance with the Resolution No. 40 are implemented by the Regulation of the Cabinet of Ministers of 4^{th} September 2012 No. 619 "Regulations on pleasure craft operators training, certification and registration" (hereinafter – Regulation No. 619), which came into force on 1^{st} January 2013.

In accordance with the paragraph 2 of the Resolution No. 40 the Ministry of Transport provides information as follows.

1. The competent authority approved for the issue of International Certificates for operators of pleasure craft (hereinafter – Certificate) in Latvia is the state owned stock company "Road Traffic Safety Directorate" (hereinafter - CSDD) in collaboration with the Latvian Yachting Union.

2. A Certificate (samples attached) is issued in accordance with Annex 3 of the Resolution No. 40. A certificate entitles to operate sailing craft (S) and/or motorized craft (M) with a length up to 24 meters in following waters:

- I inland waters,
- C1 coastal waters up to 60 nautical miles from the coast line,
- C2 offshore waters up to 150 nautical miles from the coastline,
- C3 ocean (no limits).

Certificate is valid for 10 years.

CSDD/LYU has issued 125 Certificates until now.

The Regulation No. 619 provides, that also International certificates for operators of pleasure craft, issued by the Latvian Yachting Union (hereinafter – LYU), remain to be valid until the expiry date indicated therein (a copy attached). In accordance with the Maritime Administration and Marine Safety Law the LYU was authorised to issue such certificates from June 2007 to December 2012. LYU has issued approx. 660 certificates. These certificates were issued in compliance with the Resolution No. 40.

3. A Certificate is issued to a person who meets the requirements of Annex 1 of the Resolution No. 40:

- has reached 16 years of age;
- is a citizen of Latvia, permanent resident of Latvia or has obtained a residence permit of Latvia;
- has passed health assessment;
- has successfully mastered training programme and has maritime practice appropriate to the category of the craft;
- has passed an theoretical and practical examination appropriate to the category of the craft.

An applicant has to prove in the examination:

• knowledge of the relevant regulations and nautical publications, especially the UNECE European Code for Navigation on Inland Waterways (CEVNI) and the 1972 Convention on the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea (COLREG), as well as nautical and technical knowledge, necessary for safe operation of recreational craft;

- nautical and technical knowledge and ability to apply it in practice:
 - General knowledge of craft, use and carriage of safety equipment;
 - General knowledge of the vessel's engine and proper functioning of sails;
 - Operating the craft and understanding the influence of wind, current, interaction and limited keel clearance;
 - Conduct during meeting and overtaking other vessels;
 - Anchoring and mooring under all conditions;
 - Manoeuvring in locks and ports;
 - General knowledge of weather conditions;
 - General knowledge of navigation, in particular establishing a position and deciding a safe course.

• Applicant's skills in action in specific circumstances and related knowledge:

- Principles of accident prevention;
- Action in case of collisions, engine failure and running aground, including the sealing of a leak, assistance in cases of emergency;
- Use of lifesaving devices and equipment;
- Fire prevention and fire-fighting;
- Avoiding water pollution.

In the practical test an applicant has to prove following skills and related knowledge:

- Craft supply standards;
- Preparation of the departure of craft;
- Craft's departure and arrival;
- Manoeuvre "Man over board!";
- Ride through the delta distance.

In order to get a certificate for operating pleasure craft in inland waters and coastal waters, an applicant has to complete an appropriate training and the examination. In order to get a Certificate for operating pleasure craft in offshore waters and ocean (area without restrictions), an applicant has to complete appropriate marine practice under supervision of an experienced supervisor.

4. The competent authority examines the applicant's identity, age, legal status in Latvia, medical examination, completion of the training, a marine practice certificate. A Certificate of the appropriate category is issued after the examination is successfully passed.

5. In order to recognize foreign certificates for operators of pleasure craft, issued in accordance with the Resolution No. 40, a new draft Regulation of the Cabinet of Ministers is in process of elaboration in Latvia. The Ministry of Transport will inform you respectively about adoption of this Regulation.
