# UN Transport Conventions under UNECE ITC purview

Azerbaijan, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan and Uzbekistan are contracting parties to at least 10 UN Transport Conventions



No SPECA country is contracting party to more than 20 UN Transport Conventions



All SPECA countries are contracting parties to at least 1 UN Transport Convention

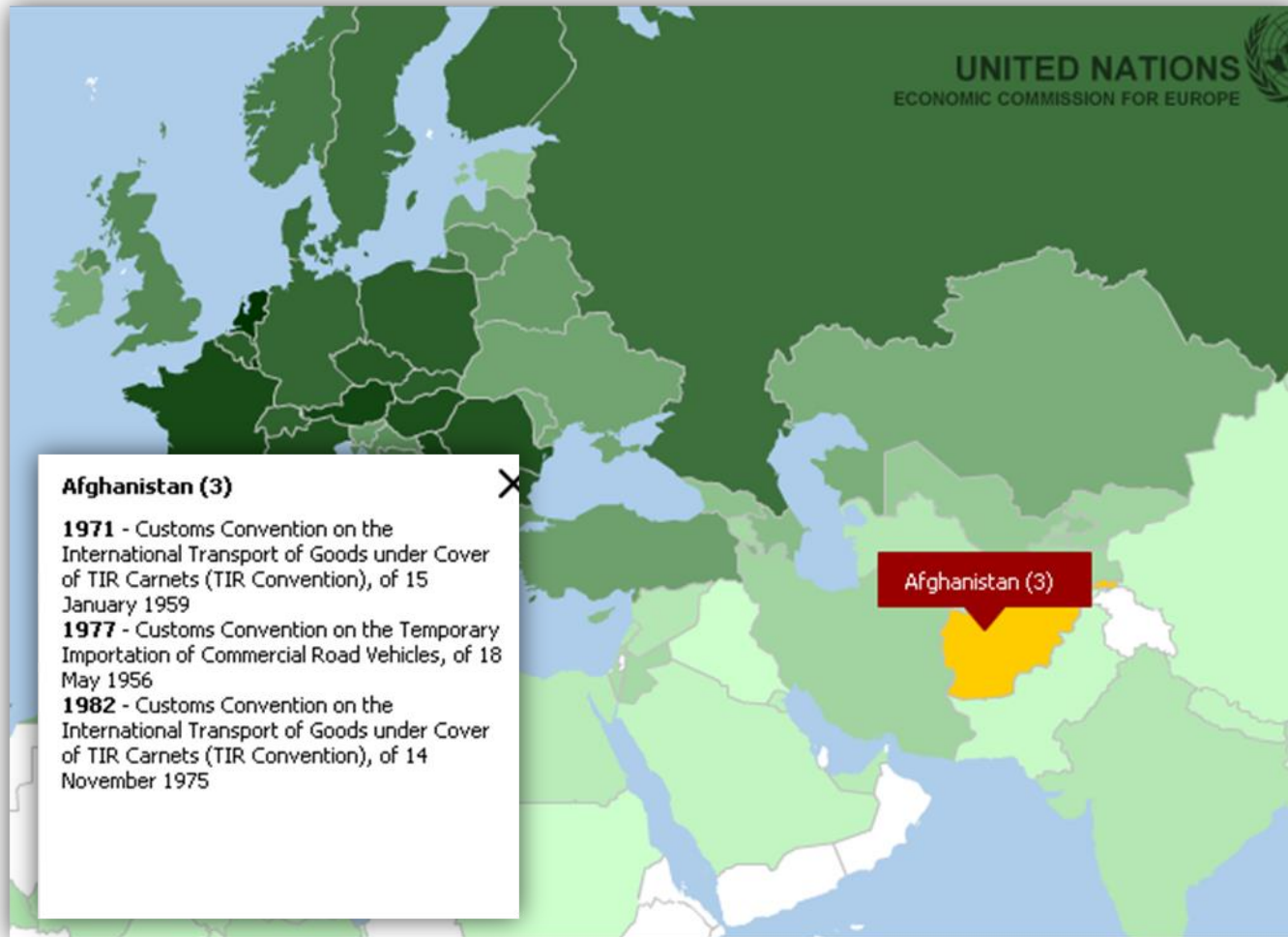


Kazakhstan is a contracting party to the highest number of UN Transport Conventions (18) among SPECA countries

All SPECA countries except Afghanistan have acceded to at least 2 Road Safety Related Convention



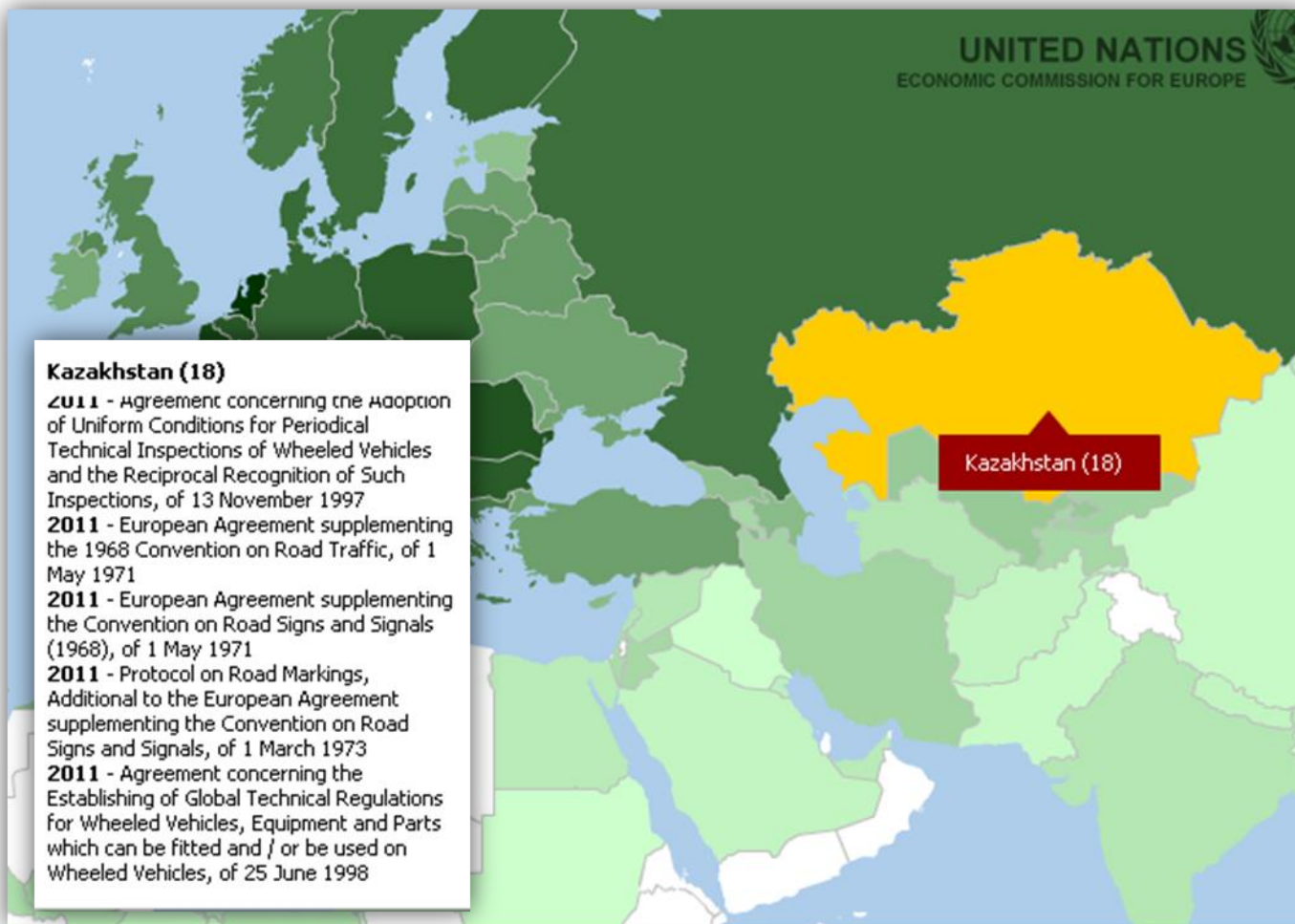



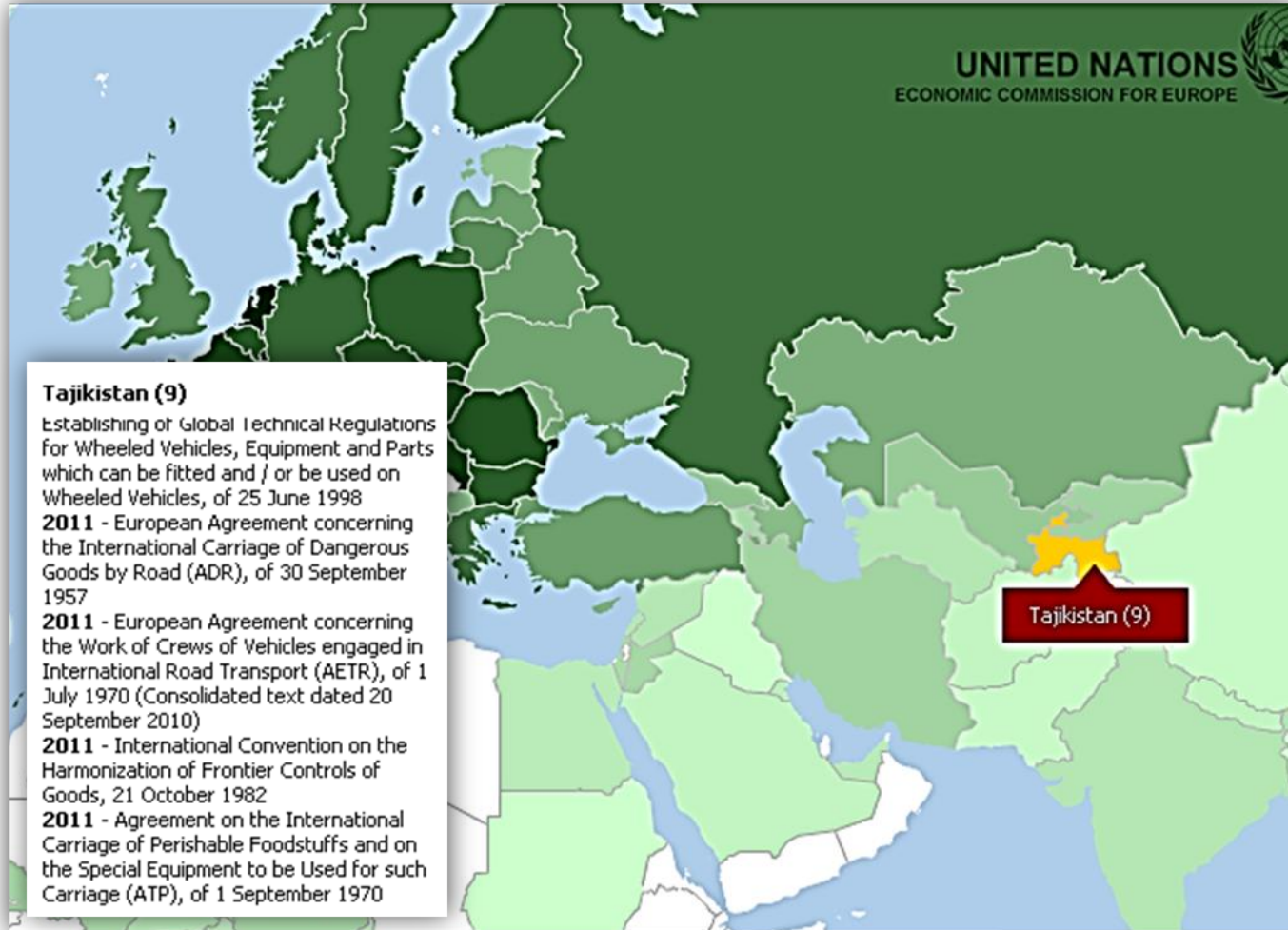
