The new draft law «On Railway Transport of Ukraine»


Railway undertaking

responsible in particular for establishing, managing and maintaining railway infrastructure, including traffic management and control-command and signalling

any public or private undertaking licensed according to the law, the principal business of which is to provide services for the transport of goods and/or passengers by rail with a requirement that the undertaking ensure traction


Minimum access package

Access charges



-Implementation of the Regulation (EC) No 1370/2007 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 23 October 2007 on public passenger transport services by rail and by road;

-Implementation of the Regulation (EC) No 1371/2007 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 23 October 2007 on rail passengers' rights and obligations into the legislation of Ukraine;

Greener and sustainable transport

PARIS AGREEMENT provides a clear pathway for climate friendly mobility

- Transport is responsible for around a quarter of the EU's greenhouse gas emissions, making it the second-biggest emitting sector after energy. More than two thirds of transport-related greenhouse gas emissions are from road transport, which contributes about 20% of the EU's total emissions of CO₂
- The implementation of climate protection actions means emission reductions and introduction of new technologies
