- Decree no.2700, dated 19.7.2000, and the law no.8638, dated 13.7.2000, “On the accession to the Vilnius Protocol of 3 June 1999 on the modification of the Convention on International Rail Transport (COTIF) , on May 9, 1980 ”
- Decree no. 4399, dated 17.11.2004, of the President of the Republic of Albania, and law on uniform rules for the contract of international rail transport of passengers and luggage (CIV)

- The Economic and Investment plan for WB6
- The COMM is launched on date 06.10.2020
- Creation of greener, sustainable and fast links
- Flagship initiative axle 3 coastal connectivity

- Law apply on dispatching the rail transport
- Rail R2 links Tirana (AL) to Podgorica (MNE)
- Railway priority project is in a joint CBC plan
- Rehabilitation 120 km in ALB and 35 in MNE
