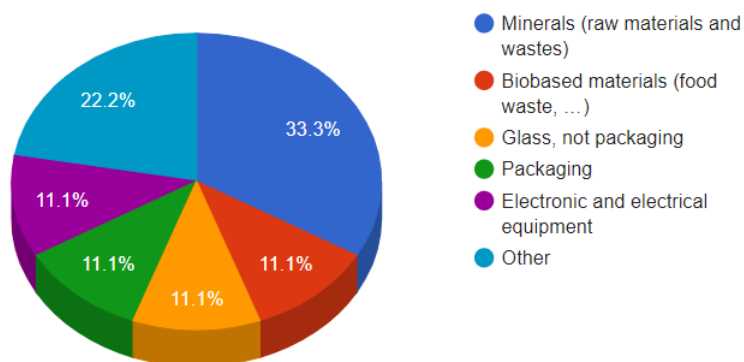
How it Works

Japanese knotweed





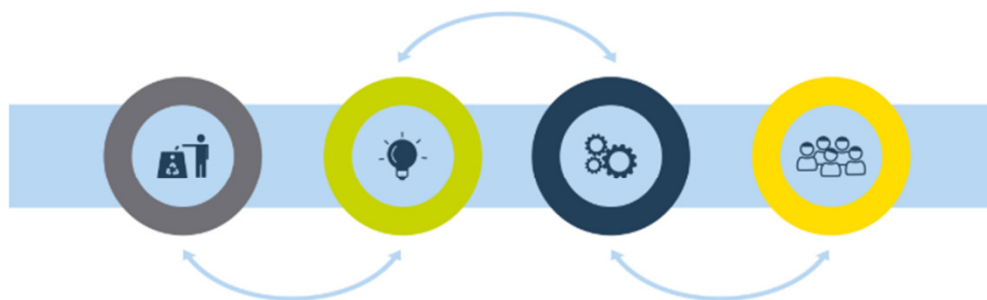
