

## **Highlights of the Minister's speech for the Moderator (February 25, 2020)**

1. As countries' economies grow, climate disasters and air pollution are becoming more serious than ever. To achieve sustainable development, it is necessary to promote industrial transition and modernization, reduce emissions and protect the environment.
2. Environmental issues are also constantly reflected in the work of the Eurasian Economic Commission (EEC), and Commission highly appreciates the work of the Inland Transport Committee in this complex and important matter.

The Eurasian roadmaps contain activities related to transport issues, provide for the coordinated development of all types of transport and their infrastructure, as well as a set of activities that are directly related to the topic of the high-level political segment, issues of ecology, security and preservation of our resources for future generations.
4. One of the key directions of the EEC project is defined as "Development of economic cooperation in the field of "green technologies" and environmental protection". Due to this, business and society of the EAEU countries will receive a clear orientation from their authorities regarding the environmental priorities of national development in the conditions of transition to the path of environmentally acceptable economic development.
