- Cooperate and connect front runners cities, countries and businesses in TDA and get greater traction and action



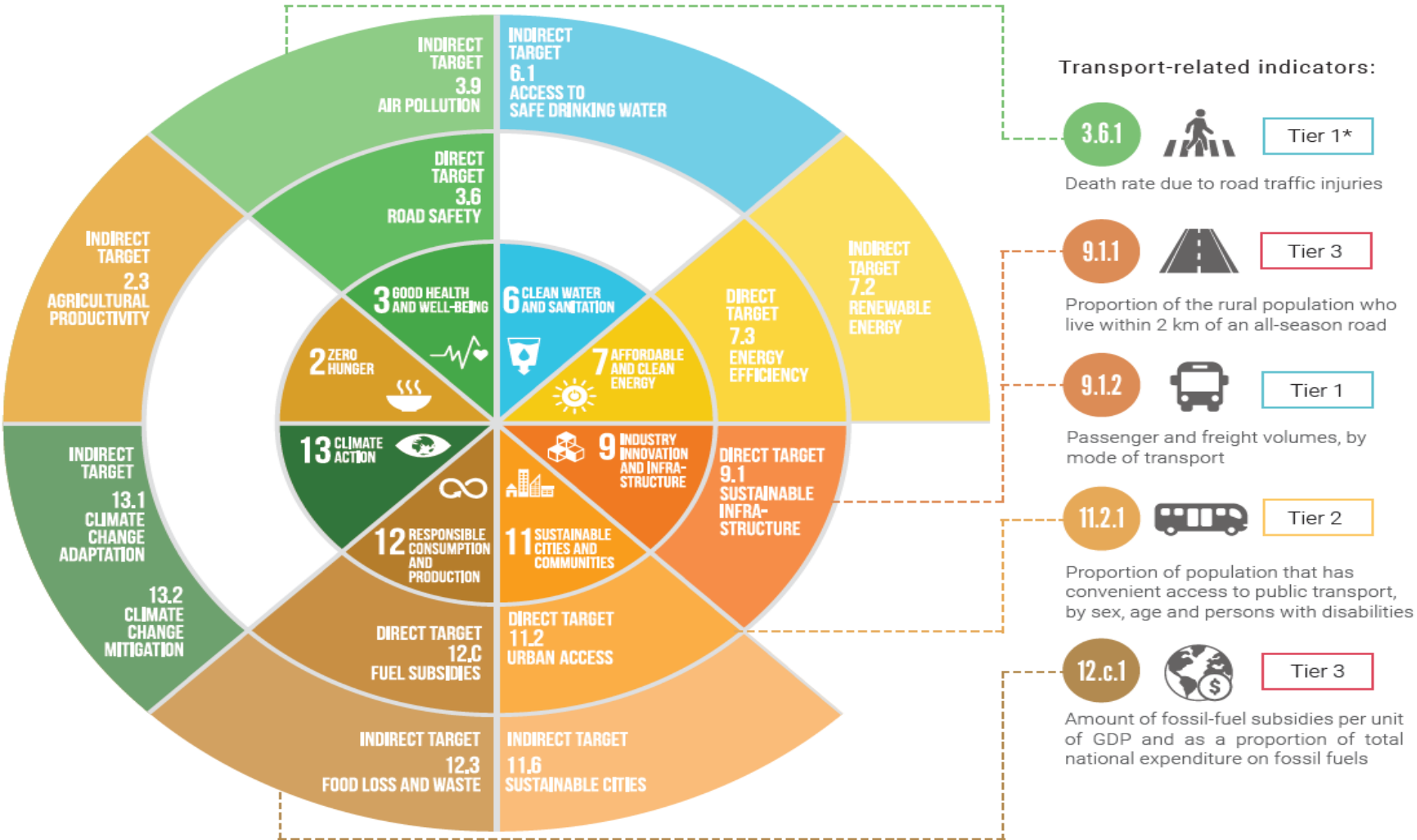
