The Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) are a universal set of goals, targets and indicators that UN member States will be expected to use to frame their agendas and policies until 2030. The 17 Global Goals with 169 targets are contained in United Nations Resolution: Transforming our world: the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development (A/RES/70/1) of 25 September 2015.

Two SDGs targets (SDG 3.6 and 11.2) are related to road safety. Results of the efficient road safety system, whether expressed in terms of reductions in deaths or injuries or taking the special care on vulnerable road users (e.g. children, pedestrians) or problematic areas (e.g. speed, driving under influence, helmet wearing) are important to demonstrate the country's ability to improve road safety situation and achieve SDG targets. Integral part of road safety system is a legal and strategic framework. Up to date legal and organizational framework and clear road safety strategy are foundations of efficient road safety management system to prevent road casualties.

The aim of the panel is to strengthen knowledge of representatives of the South-East Europe member States on road safety management, evidence-based decision making on road safety strategic goals and targets and the role of the Global Framework Plan of Action of Road Safety in development of road safety system. The panel will sensitize national stakeholders on data, information and performance indicators required for deployment and efficient monitoring of strategic goals. Exchange of the best practices on implementation of national road safety strategies/plans and institutional and legislative framework for efficient road safety management will be the key topics to be presented and discussed.
