Supplement 2 to the 02 series of amendments - Date of entry into force: 18 November 2012

Uniform provisions concerning the approval of:

- I. Rear underrun protective devices (RUPDs)**
- II. Vehicles with regard to the installation of an RUPD of an approved type**
- III. Vehicles with regard to their rear underrun protection (RUP)**

Paragraph 31.3., amend to read:

- "31.3. Starting 18 months after the applying this Regulation:
- (a) May refuse a type of component by the 02 series of amendments;
 - (b) Shall grant approvals only by the 02 series of amendments;
 - (c) May prohibit the fitting by the 02 series of amendments."

Paragraph 31.5., amend to read:

- "31.5. As from 48 months after the applying this Regulation:
- (a) Shall grant approvals only if the vehicle type to be approved meets the requirements of paragraph 2.3.(b) or paragraph 2.3.(c) or Part III of this Regulation as amended by the 02 series of amendments;
 - (b) May refuse national or regional type-approval and may refuse first national or regional registration (first entry into service) of a vehicle which does not meet the requirements of paragraph 2.3.(b) or paragraph 2.3.(c) or Part III of this Regulation as amended by the 02 series of amendments."
