Paragraph 2.17., amend to read:

- "2.17. "ISOFIX position" means a position which allows the installation of:
- (a) Either an universal ISOFIX forward facing child restraint system as defined in Regulation No. 44;
- ..."

Insert a new paragraph 5.3.8.8., to read:

- "5.3.8.8. Notwithstanding paragraph 5.3.8.1. above, ISOFIX positions are not required in ambulances or hearses as well as vehicles intended for use by the armed services, civil defence, fire services and forces responsible for maintaining public order."

Paragraph 5.3.8.8. (former), renumber as paragraph 5.3.8.9.

Annex 1,

Insert a new item 7., to read:

- "7. Utilises ISOFIX exemption permitted by paragraph 5.3.8.8. of this Regulation: Yes/No²"

Items 7. to 19. (former), renumber as items 8. to 20.
