Paragraph 1.1. (Scope), amend to read (keeping the reference to footnote 1 and the text of footnote 1):

- "1.1. This Regulation applies to motor vehicles having at least three wheels with the exception of those of categories M₁ and N₁,¹ with regard to their protection against unauthorized use, if devices to prevent unauthorized use covered by this Regulation are fitted."
