*Paragraph 6.1.2.*, amend to read:

- "6.1.2. When an assembly of two or more lamps having the same function is deemed to be a single lamp, it shall comply with the requirements for:
- (a) Maximum intensity when all lamps together are lit
  - (b) Minimum intensity if one lamp has failed."
