Dear Sir,

I acknowledge receipt of your correspondence of 30 October 2019 requesting the European Court of Human Rights under Rule 39 of the Rules of Court to order the United Kingdom authorities to revoke Article 50 of the Treaty of the European Union in order to prevent a 'no deal Brexit'.

This application falls outside the scope of Rule 39 and therefore has not been submitted to a judge for decision. The Court will not, therefore, take the measure you requested.

The Court applies Rule 39 only where an applicant faces an imminent risk of serious and irreparable damage. The vast majority of cases in which Rule 39 is applied concern deportation and extradition proceedings and involve complaints that the applicant will be at real risk of a violation of Article 2 (the right to life) or Article 3 (the right not to be subjected to torture or inhuman treatment) of the Convention, if sent to the destination State.

Please note that the Court cannot accept faxed application forms. The file opened in respect of these complaints will be destroyed in due course without further notice.
