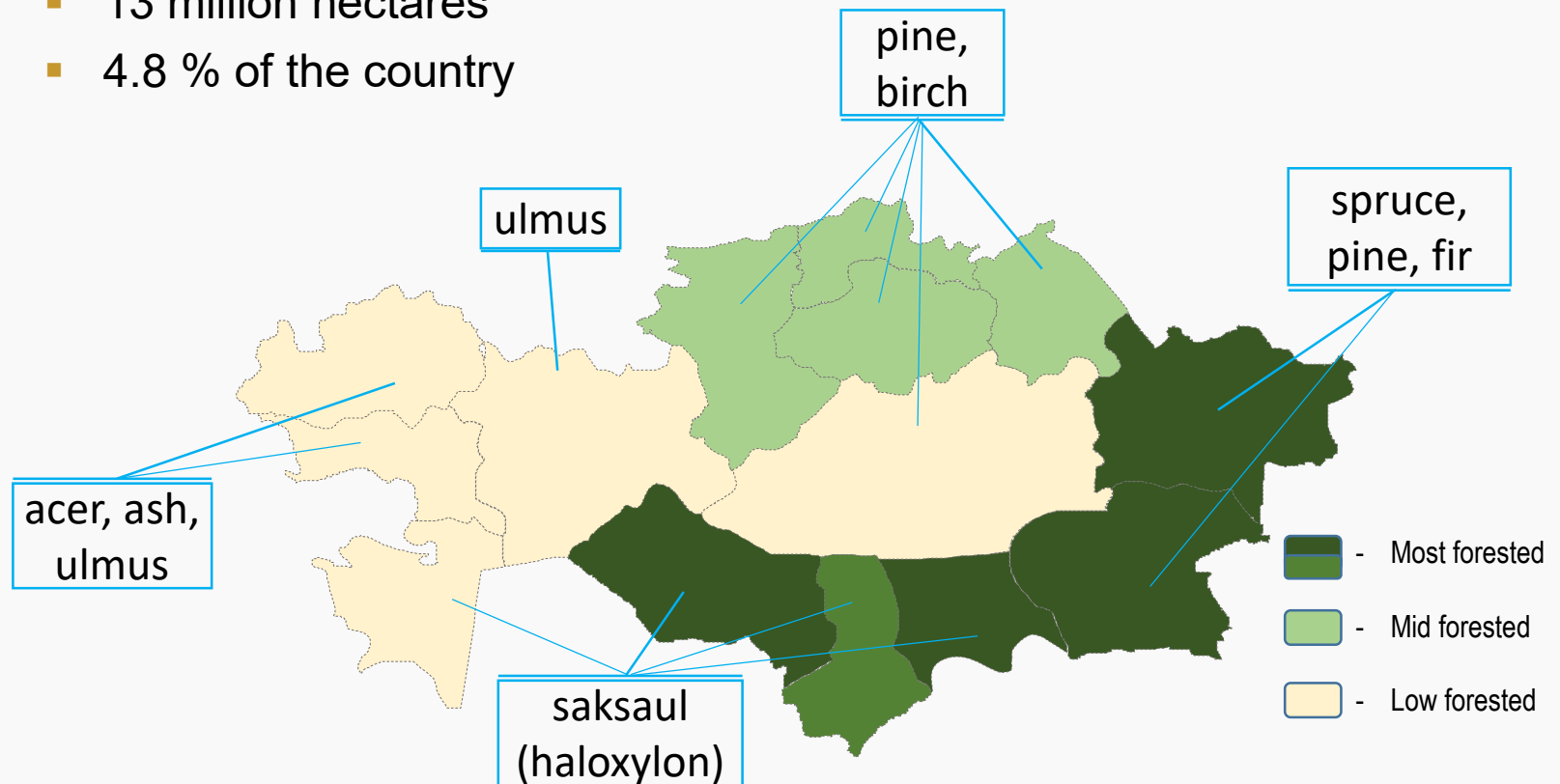
## Efforts of Kazakhstan

### FORESTS



#### Forests areas and main tree species

- 13 million hectares
- 4.8 % of the country



# Implementation of restoration targets under the Bonn Challenge

## Efforts of Kazakhstan

### FORESTS



- Main landscape degradation drivers
  - Forest fires: 630 cases and 27,000 ha forests burnt in 2020
  - Illegal logging: 270 cases and 5,300 m<sup>3</sup> forests logged in 2020
  - Desertification: about 66% of the country is deserted

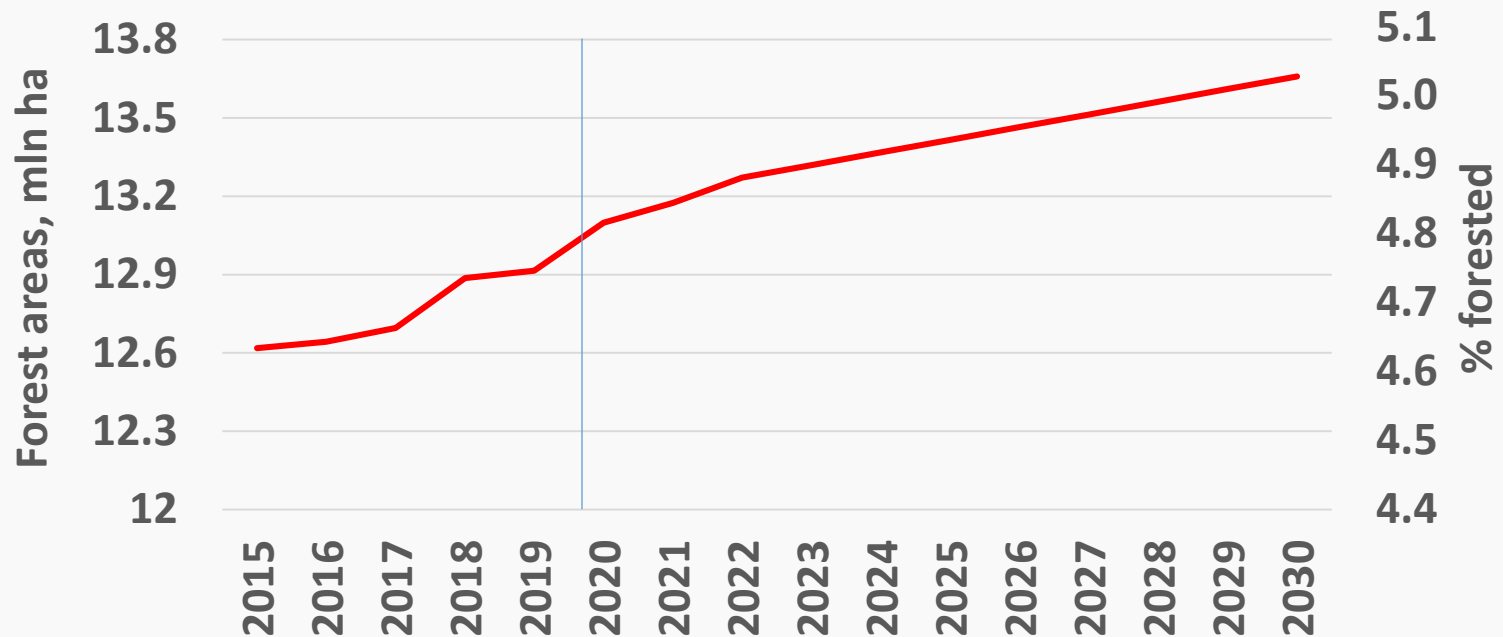
## Efforts of Kazakhstan

- The main task
  - To achieve 5% of forest cover

### Current forest cover dynamics and future projection



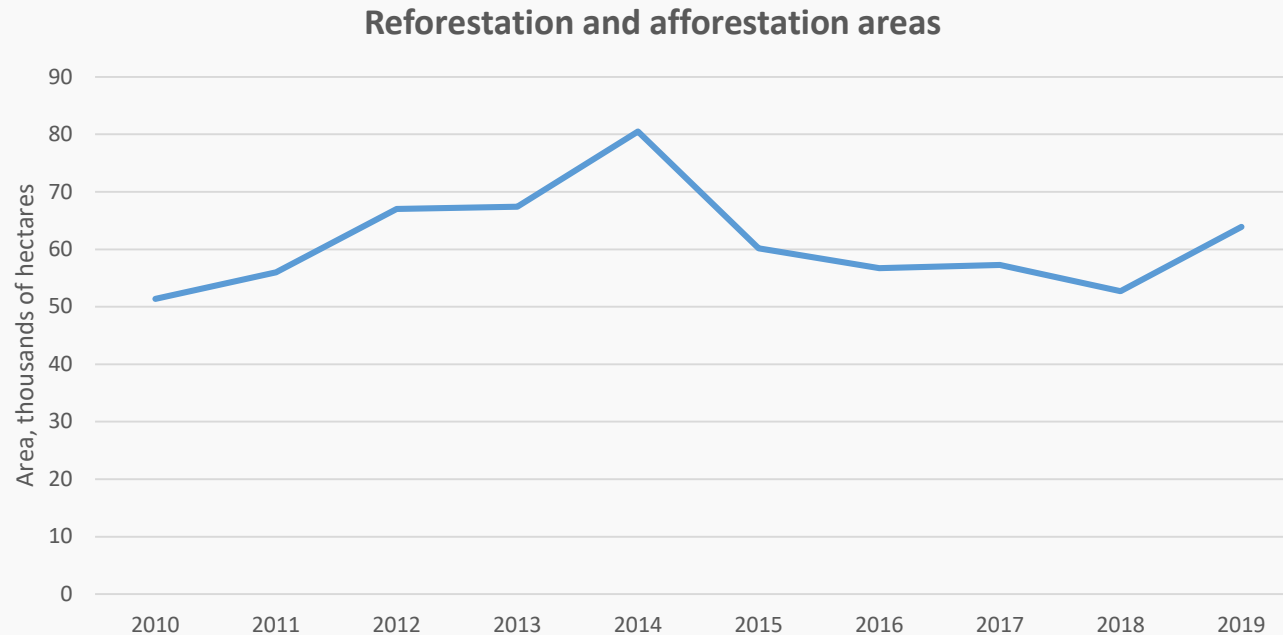
